Monday Oct 3rd

This day finished cutting in the
sawale and commenced sailing
at five o'clock and off our lee beam
the ship heading to the southward
with a fine perfectly breeze at eleven
raised a school of sperm whales

Tuesday Oct 4th

This day commenced with fine weather
and a perfectly wind at one P.M. the
boat lowered and the starboard stork
at three light him along side at six
had his body cut in middle and other
parts moderate gales from the Westward
and squally weather

Wednesday Oct 5th

This day commenced with a moderate
gale and more pleasant weather at
three got an altitude middle and latter
parts strong wind from the Westward
the ship heading to the southward

Thursday Oct 6th

This day strong wind from the west
with some rain ship by the wind
heading to the southward all hands em-
ployed in taking care of oil

Friday Oct 7th

Thine twenty-four hours moderate wind
from the westward and pleasant weather
ship bore to heading to the southward
latter part bore in the sperm pump &
cut adrift the case

Saturday Oct 8th

This day a moderate wind from West
and pleasant weather at ten cooled down
at 11. tacked ship at five stowed at the
oil 42 lbs of 58 lbs whale

Sunday Oct 9th

This day commenced with a light westerly
wind and pleasant weather at six tacked
in sail and steered. Middle part light
winds and latter part a light
breeze from the eastward course. 11.

Monday Oct 10th

This day moderate wind from the
westward and pleasant weather at
three got a superior middle part rather
heavy latter part by the wind
with fine barboard back aboard

Tuesday Oct 11th

This day commenced with moderate
wind from the westward and pleasant
weather at eight P.M. passed a ship standing
to the southward tacked ship and
stood to the southward at six tacked
and stood to the northward at eleven
drope for the Cabina New York 12 mo.
out 150000. 100 lbs

Wednesday Oct 12th

This day commenced with a gale of wind
from the westward and squally weather
at twelve tacked and stood to the south-
ward middle and latter part moderate
gales and squally weather

Thursday Oct 13th

This day a gale of wind from the westward
and squally weather at six were ship and
stood to the northward

Friday Oct 14th

This day moderate wind from the westward
and pleasant weather at three P.M. got an
altitude at six were ship and stood to the
southward at six made sail and tacked
ship at ten raised land ahead
