

Remarks on Board

Saturday Oct 15th

This day moderate wind from the westward and pleasant weather at three P.M. our sperm whales lowered the boats but did not get any at six were ship and stood off shore at three tacks and stood in for the land

Sunday Oct 16th

This day light baffling winds and pleasant weather at six took in sail and stood off shore at six took made sail

Monday Oct 17th

First part of the twenty-four hours light baffling wind at one P.M. lowered the boats for whales at five came aboard without any at six took in sail latter part wind from the westward at ten raised land on point off our lee bow ship by the wind with her larboard tacks aboard

Tuesday Oct 18th

This day light baffling winds and pleasant weather at six P.M. took in sail and stood off shore at six took made sail again

Wednesday Oct 19th

This day light baffling wind and pleasant weather at four raised a dead whale at five had him along side at ten got him cut in and started the works at eleven raised two right whales lowered the west boat but did not strike

Thursday Oct 20th

This day commences with light calm and pleasant weather at one raised a right whale lowered the boats by the boat struck and by accident cut the line middle part of the rope used for a cathead latter part freshened to a gale

Barque Elizabeth

Friday Oct 21st

These twenty-four hours a gale of wind from the eastward ship drove to within her larboard tacks aboard

Saturday Oct 22nd

This day a heavy gale of wind from the eastward and wet weather at four P.M. put the ship on the other tack

Sunday Oct 23rd

These twenty-four hours a heavy gale from the southward and eastward at ten were ship and raised a sail to windward

Monday Oct 24th

This day moderate wind from the south and wet squally weather at three were ship and heeled to the southward and eastward at six let the topsails and raised a sail off our lee beam

Tuesday Oct 25th

This day moderate wind from the southward and westward at six P.M. were ship and heeled to the

Wednesday Oct 26th

This day light winds and calm at six P.M. lowered the boats and took two black fish and shortened sail for the night latter part made sail again

Thursday Oct 27th

This day commences with a moderate breeze from the eastward and the ship by the wind heading to the northward

Friday Oct 28th

This day a moderate wind from the eastward ship by the wind head up to the northward so ends the day
