

Remarks on Board Wednesday November 19th
 these 24 hours commence with fresh gales
 from E & E and the Barko heading East
 Middle part rainy daylight more pleasant
 made all sail saw a right whale going quick
 lowered without success came on board Steered
 N E by N Lat 38° 00'

Remarks on Board Thursday November 20th
 these 24 hours commence with moderate weather the bark
 steering N E by N at 4 P M saw right whales lowered
 all 3 boats but the whales going too quick to get on
 came on board and hoisted the boats at 6 P M
 shortened sail for the night the Barko steering
 E by N the wind from the S E with a thick fog
 latter part so Lat 37° 29' Long 45° 53'

Remarks on Board Friday November 21st
 these 24 commence with light winds & foggy
 the bark steering N E the water a dead blue at
 6 P M shortened sail for the night middle part rainy
 with a thick fog at 6 A M steered of N E at 10 A M
 more clear made sail the bark heading the
 same Lat 36° 45' Long 45° 38'

Remarks on Board Saturday November 22nd
 these 24 hours commence with pleasant weather the bark
 steering N E the wind from the S W saw finbacks
 at sunset shortened sail for the night the weather
 thicker latter part more moderate the weather
 thicker so ends Lat Long

Remarks on Board Sunday November 23rd
 these 24 hours commence with light airs and foggy
 the Barko heading S W the wind from the Eastward
 at sunset shortened sail for the night the bark heading
 South daylight saw a ship to the N E steering
 to the S W made all sail steered for her at 6 A M
 spoke the ship Europa of Bremen Cork 2 1/2 months
 out bound for the Sandwich islands direct
 Lat 36° 45' Long 46° 25'

Remarks on Board Monday November 24th
 these 24 hours commence with pleasant weather the
 Bark steering S W by S at 2 P M parties company
 and steered S W at 6 P M shortened sail for the
 night and steered S W by S mid and latter part a
 thick fog and light airs Lat Long
