

Remarks on Board Tuesday November 25th
these 24 hours commenced with a light breeze from
the West at 6 P.M. shortened sail at 8 raining at
10 lightened up with fresh gales from the S.W.
Lat 37° 23' Long 46° 32'

Remarks on Board Wednesday November 26th
these 24 hours commenced with light breeze from
the S.W. with a heavy swell at 2 wore ship to the
N.W. at 4 P.M. set the foresail and double
reefed foretopsail. midnight moderate daylight
the wind from the N.W. made all sail
standing to the S.W. Lat 37° 24' Long 47° 02'

Remarks on board Thursday November 27th
these 24 hours commenced with pleasant weather the bark standing
to the S.W. at sunset took in the light sails
and steered W by S & S latter part the wind from
the north and the bark steering the same.
under all sail Lat 38° 45' Long 48° 35'

Friday November 28

commenced with a fresh
breeze from the S.W. the bark steering W by N.
Sunset shortened sail for the night daylight a fresh
breeze set the foresail and reef topsail latter part
made all sail steered W by S Lat 37° 44' Long 49° 42'

Remarks on Board Saturday November the 29th
these 24 hours commenced with light winds from
the north the bark steering W by S sunset shortened
sail for the night middle part wore ship daylight
a calm latter part light airs from the
N.E. the bark standing to the westward
Lat 37° 47'

Remarks on Board Sunday November the 30th
Commenced with cloudy weather the bark
the bark steering West at 3 P.M. light air and
rain at 4 P.M. a fresh breeze with rain double
reefed the topsails and luffed to the wind the bark heading
to the southward saw a number of birds and two large
middle part fresh gales daylight made short sail
at 7 A.M. wore ship to the North at 9 A.M. saw a
W.M. Brig to the Westward steering S.W. by W
so ends water all sorts Lat 38° 25' Long 50° 20'

Remarks on Board Monday Dec 1st 1845
these 24 hours commenced with a gentle breeze from
the S.W. the bark standing to the North under
easy sail saw a number of porpoises & finbacks
the water changeable sunset shortened sail for the
night middle part wore ship to the N.E. daylight
made short sail with a fresh breeze at 6 A.M.
wore ship to the S.W. sent down the fore topsail
to repair at sunset sent it up again Lat 38° 57' Long 51° 18'
