

Remarks on Board Saturday Decth 20th
 These 24 hours commence with a gale at 2 P.M. as pleasant
 breeze from the S.W. and set the fore course and fore top sail
 saw a great number of birds and porpoises the ground
 very lively middle part much the same at daylight wore
 ship the Southward saw a number of porpoises and birds
 saw a number of tallow drops so ends Lat 38°45' Long 51°32'

Remarks on Board Sunday Decth 21st
 first part these 24 hours begin with light airs and baffling saw
 a number of birds and porpoises at 2 P.M. wore ship to the
 Southward at sunset shortened sail for the night the bark
 steering S.S.W. at 12 midnig let took in the fore
 sail with a gale at 10 A.M. set the foresail at 11 hauled
 it up again so ends with a gale and thick weather
 latitude 38°57'

Remarks on Board Monday Decth 22nd
 these 24 hours commence with a gale from the N.W.
 and the bark heading N.E. by E saw a cocoa nut
 adrift middle part much the same at daylight made
 all sail the bark heading to the N.W. saw 2 sails
 1 off the lee beam and other off the lee bow
 at meridian spoke the ship Benjamin Bunk
 of Warren 2 months out Smith eleon bound
 for N. West coast so ends these 24 hours
 Lat 38°44' Long 51°24'

Remarks on Board Tues Decth 23rd
 these 24 hours commence with brisk gales and cloudy
 still in company with the said ship at 1 P.M. double
 reefed the topsails it blowing fresh from the south at
 sunset parted from the ship the bark heading N.E. by E
 took in the main course middle part brisk breeze
 the bark heading the same latter part much the same
 so ends these 24 hours Lat 38°18' Long 52°14'

Remarks on Board Wednesday Decth 24th
 these 24 hours begin with brisk gales from the N.W.
 and the bark heading N.E. by E at 4 P.M. took in
 the fore top sail middle part much the same
 at daylight set the fore ^{top sail} course it blowing fresh
 latter part much the same so ends Lat 38°48' Long 52°01'

Remarks on Board Thurs Decth 25th
 these 24 hours begins as the last ended with one
 sail in sight steering to the south probably a whaler
 saw a number of porpoises middle part much the
 same at 12 wore ship to the westward daylight fine
 weather made all sail the bark heading to the
 Westward latter part much the same
 so ends these 24 hours
 Latitude 38°48' Longitude 52°12'
