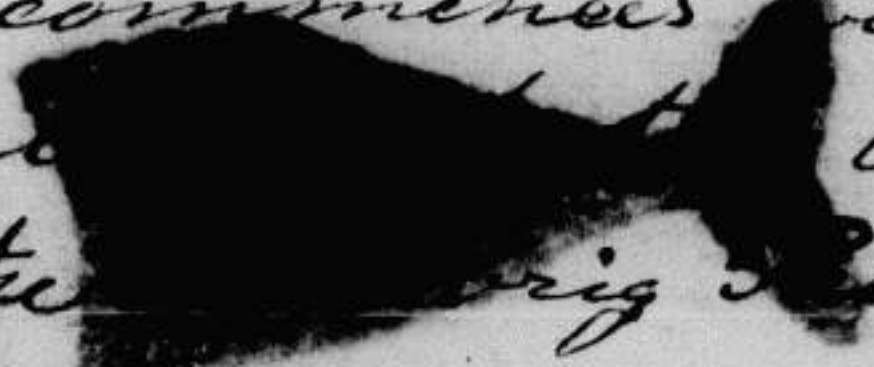


Bark Elizabeth bound from the River Plate
Monday April the 6th 1846 commences with
a calm with the same W. N. brig in sight middle
part a calm at daylight the Hoern brig in sight & mid
off latter part a calm saw another sail to the W. N. 78
So ends Lat 15 20 Lon 32 35 Tues

Tuesday April the 7th commences with a calm
at 2 P.M. the Mate. Nor issued  Carboard
boat and went on board the  rig Saraca
of New York got a few oranges and came on board
at 3 P.M. took a breeze from the S.E. and steered S by E.
middle and latter part the same saw a sail to the
S 78 So ends Lat 16 35 Lon 32 48

Wednesday April the 8th commences
with light winds from the S.E. and the bark
heading S by E under all sail Employed in fixing
the rigging Middle part at 12 midst saw a ship to the N.E.
Steering to the South at daylight saw a Peruvian Brig to the
East steering to the S.W. at 7 A.M. saw a sail to the West
Employed in tarring and fixing the rigging Saw nothing more
of Kate So ends

Bark Elizabeth Bound For Mattapoissett

Thursday April the 9th 1846
these 24 hours commences with light trades from the N.E. and
the Bark Steering North Employed in tarring and fixing the rigging
Middle part light winds and the bark Steering North
At daylight saw 2 sails at 10 A.M. passed a Prussian Bark
Steering to the S.W. Saw nothing more of Kate So ends
Lat 12 00 Long 33 24

Friday April the 10th
first part of these 24 hours light winds the Bark
Steering N. by W. at 4 P.M. saw a sail to the N.E. at sunset
passed passed two miles to the leeward of her caught
at sunset a fine Cowfish  Middle part the wind
hauling to North at daylight light gales and the bark heading to
the North the watch Employed in tarring and fixing the rigging
Saw nothing of Kate So ends Lat 10 17 Long 33 36

Saturday April the 11th
first part light airs and baffling the watch employed
in fixing the rigging at 5 P.M. saw a shoal of Black
fish middle part light airs at 11 A.M. saw a shoal of sperm
whales  covered all 3 boats and got 2 cows at 1 P.M.
got them  along side and commenced cutting at
P.M. got 1 in and set the watch So ends Lat 9 31
