

Bark Elizabeth Bound for Matlapoisett

Saturday April the 18th 1846

these 24 hours commence with light trades the bark steering N^W by N & saw a number of porpoises middle part brisk breezes latter part much the same saw nothing lat 47th lon 48³⁵

Sunday April the 19th commences with fine pleasant weather the bark steering N^W by N & under all sail at sunset saw sports of the sea how called them black fish saw them once no more  latter part brisk breezes saw nothing so ends lat 48⁵⁶ lon 49⁰⁵

Monday April the 20th commences with fine pleasant weather the bark steering N^W by N & under all sail middle part squally at 2 P.M. parted the leach rope to the foretop sail middle and latter part squally at 4 A.M. took in fore & main top gallant sails and single reefed the foretop sail at made all sail again saw nothing of note so ends lat 48³⁹ lon 49³⁹

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Tuesday April the 21st 1846 commences with fine pleasant weather the bark steering N^W by N & under all sail middle part rainy latter part rainy the bark steering the same saw nothing of note so ends employed in fixing the rigging & c. so ends lat 48⁵⁵ N longitude 49⁴⁴ W

Remarks. On Board Wednesday April the 22nd these 24 hours commence with thick weather in squalls the bark steering N^W by N & under all sail middle and latter part squally with an abundance rain saw nothing of note so ends lat 49⁵⁹ N longitude

Thursday April the 23rd commences with light baffling winds from various parts of the globe middle part brisk breezes from the ESE the bark steering N^W by N & latter part brisk breezes and clearing saw finbacks saw nothing more of note so ends lat 49⁵⁸ N longitude 49⁰⁴ West

Friday April the 24th commences with thick weather and a fresh breeze from ESE the bark steering N^W by N & under all sail middle and latter part the same so ends lat 49³⁰ lon 48⁴¹
