Remarks On Board Wednesday April 2nd
this being the day mistaken for Thursday
begins with fine weather the bark steering
N 78° E, saw so gulf weed saw nothing more
of note ends Lat 17° 41' Long 60° 57'

Remarks On Board Friday May the 1st
commences with fine weather the bark steering
N 78° E saw sail to the S.E. and some gulf
weed. Middle part pleasant gales from the S.E. and the
bark steering the S.W. saw nothing more of note.
So ends Latitude 17° 02' Longitude 58° 22'

Remarks On Board Saturday May the 2nd
these 24 hours commence with brisk breezes from the
S.E. and the bark steering N 78° E, at 4 P.M. saw a first bark
at 5 P.M. passed her, the S.W. Brig steering to the S.W. middle
part pleasant gales latter part pleasant gales the bark
steering the same So ends Latitude 20° 46' Long 60° 08'

Remarks On Board Sunday May the 3rd
these 24 hours commence with brisk breezes from the S.E.
the bark steering to the N 78° E, ^{this day caught a porpoise} saw a quantity of gulf
weed saw nothing more of note so ends Lat 22° 01' Long 61° 58'

Remarks On Board Monday May the 4th
these 24 hours commence with brisk breezes from
the S.E. and the bark steering N 78° E
middle part pleasant gales with passing clouds latter
part much the same saw nothing of note so ends
Lat 24° 02' N Long 62° 38' W

Remarks On Board Tuesday May the 5th
these 24 hours commence with pleasant gales from the
S.E. and the bark steering to the N 78° E, at 5 P.M.
wind hauled to the S.W. with some rain took in
the light sails middle part gentle breezes from the S.W.
latter part light airs and baffling the bark steering
the same with some rain so ends Lat Long
