these 24 hours commence with pleasant gales from the S.W.
and the bark steering S.W. by S. & S saw large quantities
of Gulf weed middle part brisk breeze from the S.W.
at 2 P.M. saw an H.M. Brig steering to the N.W. by W.
saw large quantities of Gulf weed saw nothing more of
note so ends Lat 26° 39' Long 63° 54'

Remarks on Board Thursday May the 7th
these 24 hours commence with pleasant gales from
the S.W. and the bark steering S.W. by S. & S
middle part brisk breeze from the S.W. and the
bark steering S.W. by S. latter part brisk breezes
saw a sail to the South steering to the South saw
nothing more of note so ends Lat 27° 42' Long 65° 11'

Remarks on Board Friday May the 8th
these 24 hours commence with fine pleasant
gales the bark steering S.W. by S middle part
light air from the S.W. at daylight saw a Heron
in the air saw a bird called the boatswain taken
by a hawk after chasing him for some 5 minutes
at 7 A.M. went the foretop sail to repair saw
nothing of note so ends

Remarks on Board Saturday May the 9th
these 24 hours commence with fine pleasant weather
the bark steering S.W. by S. at 4 P.M. set the foretop sail
saw a yellow tail middle part light air with passing
clouds and some rain saw nothing of note so ends
Latitude by Observation 28° 56' Long by Chron 66° 44' W

Remarks on Board Sunday May the 10th
these 24 hours commence with light air from the South and
the bark steering S.W. by S & S saw a number of Porpoises
middle part brisk breeze from the South and the bark
steering S.W. by S latter part the same so ends
Latitude 31° 34' West Longitude 67° 29' W

Remarks on Board Monday May the 11th
these 24 hours commence with brisk breezes from the
S.W. and the bark steering to the S.W. by S middle
part strong breezes from the south and the bark steering
S.W. by S latter part at 9 A.M. saw a brig steering to the
South at 11 A.M. saw a ship steering to the East saw
nothing more of note so ends
Latitude 34° 12' Longitude 68° 40'
