

Bark Elizabeth Bounov For Her 1846

Remarks on Board Tuesday May the 12<sup>th</sup>  
these 24 hours commence with strong breezes from  
the South and the bark steering S<sup>W</sup> by S, at 2 P.M.  
the wind hauled to the S<sup>W</sup> and the bark  
heading S. by E at 5 P.M. saw a sail steering to  
the South middle part strong winds from the S<sup>W</sup> and  
the bark steering to the or heading to the S. by E. at daylight  
saw 2 bays and one bark the latter looking much like  
an English vessel that lost her mainmast and had  
a jury mainmast in its place she steering to the  
S. by E passed about 1/4 of an mile astern saw nothing  
more of Note so ends lat 35°36' long 47°42'

Remarks on Board Wed<sup>nesday</sup> May the 13<sup>th</sup>  
these 24 hours commence with strong breezes from  
the S<sup>W</sup> and S. by E and the bark steering or  
rather heading to the S. by E saw nothing more of  
Note till morning when we take the wind from the  
South and steer S<sup>W</sup> by S. saw a sail to the S. by E,  
saw nothing more of Note so ends these 24 hours  
Latitude 36°23'  
Longitude 48°28'

Port Of Destination Or Matlapoisett 1846

Remarks on Board Thursday May the 14<sup>th</sup>  
first part light airs from the South and the  
bark steering S<sup>W</sup> by S. saw a sail steering to  
the West middle part fresh breezes from the  
South at 12 midnight struck the gulf  
at daylight saw a large shoal of small sperm  
whales of the starboard bow kept the ship for  
them at 2 P.M. ~~lowered~~ lowered all the boats  
without success the whales going quick to the  
windward saw them 2 rising and no more  
saw a sail to the S<sup>W</sup> steering to the East  
saw once more sail steering to the west  
so ends lat 38°55' long 59°43'

Remarks on Board Friday May 15<sup>th</sup>  
these 24 hours commence with fresh breeze  
from the south and the bark steering  
to the S<sup>W</sup>, saw 2 sails steering to the  
west middle part fresh breezes from the South  
and the bark steering S<sup>W</sup> by S. at daylight the  
water discolored sounded no bottom saw  
a number of fish backs so ends
