hand employ in recruiting the Ship in the harbour of
Fajal and sounds these 24 hours & L. & C.

August the 15 Day these 24 hours Commences with lay-
ing off & on & at 1 Pm made sail & Steaming S. E. by E.
South & all hands employed in bunching Quivers and & L.
and at 5 Pm a strong breeze from the S. S. E. & L. and mid-
dle parts Calms & off the west end of St. George at 6 Am
Saw black fish at half past 7 Am the watch cauled
& Calms and latter parts of these 24 Ends with Calms and
we are now off the side of St George one of the
western islands and all hands employed in putting
unions & Sams a making nests & Sounds these 24 hours & C.

August the 16 Day these 24 hours Commences with calms
and all hands employed in putting up unions and
potatoes & at 6 Pm 4 ports Guas manans boats
came on board of us and overhauled us and then went on board of
their Ship and light winds and Calms and at 8 Am Sails insight
& at 7 Am the watch cauled and the Mate went a Shore to
St. Georges island to trade with the portugues and Calms & pleasant
weather & L. and sounds these 24 hours close to the South point
of St. George island and sounds these 24 hours and the Mate
a Shore a trading with the portugues & Calms & pleasant & C.

August the 17 Day these 24 hours Commences with light
winds from the S. W. & pleasant weather & the Mate a
Shore a trading with the portugues & L. and at 8 Pm
the Mate came on board & fetched fresh hogs, hens,
onions, Eggs and potatoes & pumpkin & L. and light wind
and pleasant weather & L. and middle parts light winds & at 4 Am
the watch cauled & Got a boat ready for going a Shore to trade with

the Portugues on the North end of St. Georges island at 8 Am
Calms & L. at 10 Am the boat came a board & fetched fresh
and discharge them and went on Shore a Grain and at 12 the boat
came on board & fetched fresh hogs & L. and sounds these 24
hours

August the 18 Day these 24 hours Commences with light
winds & pleasant weather & we take our departure from St. George
& all hands employed in Ship Duty a lashing anchors and giving
a Spar at the mast the forecanted & at 6 Pm knock of work and
winds North and all Sails set & L. and middle parts light breezes
from the north and at 6 Am to Sails insight & half past 7 Am
the watch cauled and employed in Ship Duty and the island of
Pico bearing N. W. by N. 60 miles Distance from which
take my departure & L. and it being late in 58. 56 North
and Long in 28. 55 West & Sounds these 24 hours and
late in by Chk 37. 18 North and that is the last of

August the 19 Day these 24 hours Commences with pleasant
weather & the watch employed in Ship Duty & all Sails
set and the winds East & Course South & at 6 Pm knock
of work & fresh breeze from the East & L. and

at half past 7 Am the watch cauled & employed in
Ship Duty a making rope & Sounds these 24 hours &
late in by Chk 35. 08 North and Long in 28. 08 West

August the 20. th Day these 24 hours Commences with
fresh breezes from the East & Course S. by W. and the
watch employed in Ship Duty and thick weather & L. at 4
Pm got out water & fresh breezes from the East at half past 6
Pm knock off work at 8 Pm Strong breeze & Cloudy weather
& L. and middle parts fresh breezes from the East and Course
S. by W. & at half past 7 Am the watch cauled & employ-
ed in Ship Duty & fresh breezes from the east and L. & latter parts
more moderate and pleasant weather and late in by Chk 32. 56.
North and long in 28. 08 West Long in & C.
