

August the 29. Day the year of our Lord 1829. & C.
 Remarks On board the Ship Albion of Fairhaven. Capt
 and master "Bound On the Coast of Patagonia On a whaling voyage
 first part of these 24 hours Commenced With light winds from the
 North & course South & the watch employed in Ships Duty at 4 Am. Calm
 & at 7 Am knock off work & at 8 Am winds N. E. & light rain & C.
 and middle parts light winds & pleasant weather at 1 Am calm
 at 2 Am Sun rain at 3 Am a light breeze of wind from
 the west & C. at half past 7 Am the watch covered & employed
 in Ships Duty & wind from the S. S. W. & pleasant weather & latter
 part winds the same & S. S. W. by E. 12. 10 North.
 And Long In 25. 45. -- West - Long in 8. Sound & C.

August the 30. Day These 24 hours Commenced with pleasant
 weather and light winds from the S. S. W. and the watch employed
 in Ships Duty & C. at 4 Am all hands employed in picking
 over betelots at half past 6 Am knock off work at 7 Am
 Sun rain squalls at 2 Am the same and winds from
 the W. S. W. at 7 Am a shift of wind out to the
 the South & West and a severe Rain squall and carried over
 ply. S. S. W. Damage our mainsail Sun & misen topgalant
 sails & the squall continued about a half an hour & possible
 reefed topsail & C. at 10 Am reefed out of the topsails and
 set the misen topgalant at 11 Am pilot a gain. and
 bound these 24 with thick cloudy weather & winds S. by W
 and W. C. this Day but by Tide reckoning we are in
 Lat 10. 49 North and Long in 25. 13. West & Sound & C.

August the 31. Day These 24 hours Commenced With strong breeze
 from the S. W. at 1 Am single reefed topsail & Squally and overboard
 the Mainsail & all hands repairing it at 3 Am reefs out and cut
 down the misen topgalant yards & royal yards & on board the ply gills
 & C. at 4 Am hant another mainsail at 6 Am knock off work and
 light breeze from S. W. by W. & Cloudy weather & C. and middle parts
 light winds the W. N. W. & C. at half past 7 Am the watch covered
 and all hands employed in Ships Duty repairing the mainsail & Sun
 picking over betelots and at 10 Am Commenced raining & latter
 part of these 24 hours raining and W. C. this Day but by
 Tide reckoning we are in 10. 58 North Lat. and Long in 26. 53.
 West Long In 26. 53. Sound & C. & C.

Ship Albion Fairhaven Bound on the Coast of
 Patagonia Capt Read Munster and it was month of September
 the 1. 1829. & C. These 24 hours Commenced With a good breeze
 from the W. N. W. and Cloudy weather & all hands in Ships
 Duty & the mainsail and Sun picking over betelots & caught a
 porpoise & at 2 Am saw the spout of a whale but it was so
 far that we could not tell what kind it was and
 we let him pass & C. and at 6 Am knock off work & light
 breeze from the west & Cloudy & C. and middle parts light
 breeze from the West & at half past 7 Am the watch
 covered & employed and all hands employed in Ships Duty
 repairing sails and Sun a making nets over huts in
 the Cabin and stowing a way betelots and Sun a making
 square yards and latter part of these 24 hours light wind
 and pleasant weather and Lat in by C. 16. 36 North and
 Long In 24. 40 West -- Long In 8. Sound & C.

September the 2. Day These 24 hours Commenced With
 light winds from the W. S. W. and all hands employed in
 Ships Duty & C. at 4 Am cut up the misen topgalant
 and royal yards at 6 Am knock off work & C. and at 8 Am
 light breeze from the S. W. by W. and Cloudy & C. and at 10
 Am Squally & C. at 1 Am Squally and raining and at
 half past 7 Am the watch covered and employed in taking in
 sail & making sail and Squally & raining winds S. S. W.
 and latter part of these 24 hours Squally and Lat in by
 C. 17. 30 North and Long in 24. 25. West & C.

September the 3. Day These 24 hours Commenced With strong breeze
 from the S. S. W. and flying clouds and the watch employed
 in Ships Duty & C. at 2 Am on board the fore topgalant
 sail & repair at 6 Am sent it a loft and knock off work
 and winds from S. W. by S. & blowing strong and Cloudy weather
 & C. and middle parts fresh breeze from the S. W. by S. and
 and middle pleasant weather at half past 7 Am the watch covered
 & employed in making mist & fresh breeze from the S. W.
 and light rain & C. and Cloudy & C. and latter part fresh breeze
 and winds and Lat in by C. 16. 20 North and Long in
 25. 13. West Long in 8. Sound & C. & C.
