These 24 hours Commenced with Strong breezes from the
E. S. E. and all hands employed in about 10 o'clock and
Saw a strange Sail to the leeward at 6. P.M. knock off work and
middle part pleasant weather and fresh breezes from the East & Course S. E.
and at 1. P.M. a Squall from the N. E. & down rain & at half past
7 P.M. the watch called and employed in the Sabbath and latter
parts of these 24 squally and down rain and Sall in by Clock
19: 53. South and Long in 32: 31. West and Sound & C. &

Monday September 21st Day first parts of these 24 hours
Commenced with squally and down rain and at 1 P.M. saw
the Island of Trinidad having S. W. 35. miles distance
and its bearing Sall in 20: 20 South and Long in 28: 40 West
and at 3. P.M. up west of the island and middle part pleasant
weather & winds N. E. and Course S. S. W. and half past 7 P.M.
the watch called and all hands employed in Ships Duty & a fitting
number of men Sailed these 24 hours and Sall in by Clock 22: 01 South
and Long in 29: 20. West Long and Sound & C.

Tuesday September 22nd Day these 24 hours Commence with
pleasant weather & good breezes from the E. S. E. & Course S. S. W. and
all hands employed in Ships Duty at 4 P.M. saw 2 whales & they
were knocked at 6 P.M. knock off work at 8 P.M. good breezes from the
N. N. E. and pleasant weather and all sail at 8. C. and middle part
squally and winds from the N. N. E. & C. and at half past 7 P.M.
the watch called & all hands employed in Ships Duty setting up
rigging fore and aft the Ship and winds N. N. E. and Course
S. S. W. and Sound and Sall in by Clock 24. 22 South
and Long in 30. 25. West Long in and Sound

Wednesday September 23rd Day first parts of these 24 hours
Commenced with good breezes from the N. N. E. and pleasant weather
and all hands employed in Ships Duty setting up rigging at half
past 6 P.M. knock off work and at 9 P.M. a rain Squall from
from the N. W. and middle part fresh breezes & C. at half past
7 P.M. the watch called and employed in Ships Duty and fresh breeze

from the N. W. and flying Clouds and Course S. S. W. & C.
and latter parts squally and no Clock this Day best by Gods
reckoning were in 27. 02. South Sall and Long in 31: 35

Thursday September 24th the first parts of these 24 hours
commenced with rainy & squally and windy and winds S. W.
and the watch employed in Ships Duty at 2 P.M. Calms & C.
at 6 P.M. knock off work and Strong breezes from the S. S. W.
and a strange Sail in sight and middle part lack Ship & Sall to the
west and at 8 P.M. took Ship and Sall to the S. S. E. and at half
past 9 P.M. the watch called and employed in Ships Duty and Sound these 24
hours and saw a Goney and Strong breezes from the S. W.
and Sall in by Clock 28: 10. South and Long in 34: 13. West

Friday September 25th Day first parts of these 24 hours comm
enced with fresh breezes from the S. W. and all hands employed
in Ships Duty and at 3. P.M. spoke a English brig bound
to London & C. at 4 P.M. knock off work and blowing Strong
from the S. W. and middle part Strong breezes from the
west at 6 P.M. parted topgallant sails and cast down royals
at 6 P.M. single reefed topsails and half past 6 P.M. a severe
Squall of wind & rain from the west and at 8 another squall
and rain and cloud from 8. cleared up & C. and have the Ship
two and latter parts of these 24 hours and with a gale of
wind from the S. W. and Sall in by Clock 29: 09
South and Long in 34: 10 West Long & C. Long

Saturday September 26th Day first parts of these 24 hours
commenced with a gale of wind from the S. S. W. and
laying down and the watch employed in picking and
making down & C. at 6 P.M. blowing a gale of wind at 11 P.M.
was immediate and set the fore and main topsails at 3 P.M. &
the reef out of the fore sail at 5 P.M. made all sail a
winds from South and new handboard tack on board and latter
parts fresh breezes from the S. S. E. and Sall in by Clock
29: 27 South and Long in 32: 05 West Long in and
