

With 5 Whales &c. and at 8 Pm set the watch and employed in boiling Oil and pleasant weather & light winds from the South &c. and middle parts fresh breeze from the North &c. thick weather &c. at half past 2 Pm made Sail at 5 Pm saw 2 Whales and hauled and lowered away 3 boats and the Starboard boat struck the whale and ran a long way to the windward and left from the Whale and at half past 10 Pm came on board and sounds these 24 hours and Latt in by Chk 41: 54 South

And Long in 43: 14 West Long &c.

Friday November 18th these 24 hours Commences With a moderate gale of wind from the South and in company with the Ship commences Rogues of Sea beyond and all hands employed in boiling Oil &c. at 1 Pm took in all Sail & blowing strong at 3 Pm set the watch and a sail insight &c. and middle parts strong breeze from the North & rainy and at 4 Pm finish boiling Whale Oil at 5 Pm all hands hauled and employed in hauling Stowing Down Oil and 4 Sail in Sight and at 9 Pm saw right whales at 10 Pm lowered a way and got a Whale to the Starboard Boat and another to the Bow boat and sounds these 24 hours and Latt in by Chk 41: 09 South And Long in 43: 50 West &c.

Saturday November 19th first parts of these 24 hours Commences With strong breeze from the South and all hands employed in Lifting a whale along side and at half past 3 Pm Commenced Lifting in the whale and at 7 Pm finished Lifting One Whale and took in all Sail and soon raining &c. at 4 Pm all hands hauled and Commenced cutting in the Whale that we have had a long Side all night and soon raining at 1 Sail insight at 10 Pm finished cutting in the whale and light winds from the North and pleasant weather and made Sail and got the log works underway and sounds these 24 hours and Latt in by Chk 41: 06 South & Long in 42: 50 West

Sunday November 20th these 24 hours Commences With all hands employed in boiling Oil and pleasant weather and soon whales in Sight &c. and at 8 Pm took in all Sail and set the watch &c. and at 8 Pm all hands

hauled and lowered a way for Whales but did not get past and light winds & pleasant weather &c. a Sail insight at 10 Pm lowered away for whale but did not get past & sounds these 24 hours and Latt in by Chk 41: 16 South & Long in 42: 19 West

Monday November 21st these 24 hours Commences With pleasant weather & all hands employed in boiling Oil and whales insight and at 3 Pm lowered a way & the West Boat got past and saved the whale and got him a long Side at 5 Pm & Commenced cutting him in at 8 Pm knocked off & let him go and took in all Sail & set the log works to going & soon a Clearing of Rocks & Calms &c. and middle parts pleasant weather &c. at 1 Pm all hands hauled and employed in Lifting the whale at 6 Pm finished and all hands employed in Stowing Down Oil in the after hole and 2 Sail in Sight and a plenty of whales insight and Calms & pleasant weather &c. and sounds these 24 hours and Latt in by Chk 40: 58 South

And Long in 41: 15 West Long in &c.

Tuesday November 22nd These 24 hours Commences with all hands employed in boiling & Stowing Down Oil and pleasant weather & Calms & 2 Sail in Sight &c. at 6 Pm set the watch & Calms &c. and middle parts a breeze of wind from the West and at 6 Pm the watch hauled and raining and blowing strong from the W. S. W. and all hands employed in boiling Oil and Stowing Down Oil in the after hole and other parts of these 24 hours blowing a strong breeze of wind from the west & Latt in by Chk 41: 06 South

And Long in 40: 35 West & Sounds &c. &c.

Wednesday November 23rd These 24 hours Commences With a moderate Gale of wind from the West and all hands employed in boiling Oil &c. at 4 Pm the wind more moderate and 2 Sail in Sight and at 5 Pm set the watch and pleasant weather &c. at 9 Pm blowing fresh from the W. S. W. & soon rain &c. and middle parts plenty of rain & blowing strong and at 5 Pm the same kind of weather and Calms &c. the winds at 8 Pm more moderate and got the whale under way & Latt in by Chk 40: 58 South & Long in 40: 35 West
