Saw more whales and lowered a. They 3 the best best passed and after making a long way to the windward let and came on board and took in. Sail at half past 9 Am got the try works under way and light winds from the South & Cloudy &c at half past 10 Am the watch came on a plenty of Whales insight and Sound these 24 hours in Hauling and hauling Oil and light winds from the South & Let in by Ob 41° 47 South & Long in 38° 07 West.

Saturday December 19th these 24 hours Commences with calm and all hands employed with hauling & hauling Oil & c. and at 3 Am the watch Harbour boat got a Whale and at him a long Sid at 5 Am and so commenced cutting him in and finished at 8 Am and took in all Sail and at the try works under way and light winds from the South and pleasant weather and a abundance of whales insight &c. and middle part Calms &c. at 6 Am all hands Caled & employed in hauling Oil and made Sail and light winds from the West and pleasant weather & a plenty of whales insight at 7 Am lowered away 2 boats & the Harbour boat got past and saved the whale at 9 Am got the whale along Side and commenced cutting in the whale and Sound these 24 hours and Let in by Ob 41° 28 South and Long in 37° 03 West &c.

Sunday December 20th these 24 hours Commences with pleasant weather and light winds from the S. W. and all hands Caled and employed in cutting in a whale at half past 2 Am finished & got the try works under way and all hands employed in hauling Oil & Stowing down Oil at 6 Am finished and took in all Sail and the watch employed in hauling Oil &c. and middle part Calms and a breeze from the S. W. at 6 Am the watch came on and all hands employed in hauling Oil & Stowing down Oil in the after hold and Sound these 24 hours and Let in by Ob 41° 15 South and Long in 38° 21 West.

Monday December 21st the first part of these 24 hours Commences with a strong breeze of wind from the N. E. and all hands employed in hauling and Stowing down Oil at 3 Am finished Stowing down Oil & blowing strong & thick clouds &c. at 5 Am Set the watch &c. and middle part blowing strong and rainy &c. at half past 1 Am Caled down the watch and raising &c. at 4 Am got the works under way &c. and at 11 the watch Caled and all hands employed in hauling Oil and Stowing down Oil in the after hold and Sound these 24 hours with strong breeze from the N. W. and no Ob. Let in by date reckoning we are in 40° 56 South. Let in by Prod Long in 38° 08. West Long in &c.

Tuesday December 22nd these 24 hours Commences with a moderate Gale of wind from the West & Cloudy &c and all hands employed in hauling blubber and Stowing down Oil at 4 Am finished and blowing strong at 6 Am Set the one Saw a strong Sail to the windward Standing to the S. W. under. Shot Sail &c. and middle part blowing very strong from the N. N. W. &c. at 7 Am the watch Caled and all hands employed in hauling Oil and down employed in Stowing down Oil in the main hatch and blowing a gale of wind from the N. N. W. and Sound these 24 hours and Let in by Ob 41° 28 South. Prod Long in 37° 40 West &c. &c.

Wednesday December 23rd these 24 hours Commences with a Gale of wind from the N. W. and all hands employed down a hauling oil and down a Stowing down Oil at 5 Am finished hauling and Caled down the try Works at 5 Am finished Stowing down Oil all but 16 blubber and blowing very strong from the N. N. W. and down thunder & lightning and Whales insight &c. &c. and middle part a strong gale from the West &c. at 6 Am all hands Caled and blowing strong from the N. W. and rainy and at 8 Am the watch employed in clearing down &c. at 10 Am made Sail and Sound these 24 hours and Let in by Ob 41° 15 South. Prod Long in 37° 17 West Long
