Thursday January 21st These 24 hours Commences with
light winds & pleasant weather & 6 Sail insight all hands emp-
loyed in hoisting Oil & Stowing down Oil in the fore-hold
& L. at 4 Am Saw a plenty of whales and loosed a way 3
Boats & the west boat got past & the harpoon drawn and
lost the whale & came on board & took in all Sail at 8 Am
Set the watch & employed in hoisting Oil & L. and middle
part light winds from the South & L. at 6 Am the watch
cameled and employed in hoisting Oil & L. Sail insight and
a plenty of whales insight and light winds at 7 Am loosed
a way 3 Boats and the Starboard boat got past and
saw the Whale and got him along side at half past 9
Am and commenced cutting in the Whale and Sound
these 24 hours in cutting the Whale, and no Clock this Day
but by Tide reckoning we are in Lat 41:40 South
And Long in 37:31. West Long

Friday January 22nd These 24 hours Commences with
all hands employed in cutting a Whale at 1 Am finished and got
the whales underway & L. at 4 Am Saw more whales and loosed a
way 3 Boats and the Starboard boat got past and the harpoon
drawn & lost the Whale and then the Capt. boarded the Ship to
be of Sag Harbor Capt. Hands with 1200 blbls of Oil & L.
and our boats came on board and all hands employed in hoisting
Oil & Stowing down Oil in the fore-hold at 7 Am took in all
Sail at 9 Am Set the watch and employed in hoisting Oil and
hoisting strong from the East & thick weather & L. and middle part
a gale of wind & rain at 4 Am Set the long work & L. at 7 Am
the watch cameled and hoisting a gale of wind and rain from the East &
latter part of these 24 hours more moderate and no Clock this

Day but by Tide reckoning we are in Lat 41:17 South
And Long in 37:45. West Longitud & L.

Saturday January 23rd These 24 hours Commences with a
moderate gale of wind from the N.W. & L. and thick weather and
the watch employed in hoisting Oil again & L. at 6 Am the watch
cameled and employed in hoisting Oil & L. Stowing down in the
fore hold & L. at 6 Am the watch Set & L. and middle part a
light breeze of wind from the N.W. at 6 Am the watch cameled
and hoisting strong from the N.W. and thick weather the watch
employed in hoisting Oil at 7 Am Saw Whales & loosed a
way 2 boats & they both struck a Whale and lost them
and a very thick fog & came on board & blowing a gale of wind
and rain & taking all Sail and Sound these 24 hours and no Clock
this Day but by Tide reckoning we are in Lat 41:33 South
And Long In 36:35. West & L. & L.

Sunday January 24th These 24 hours Commences with all
hands employed in hoisting Oil & L. Stowing in the fore hold &
hoisting a gale of wind from the N.W. & L. at 6 Am Set the
watch & L. and middle part strong breeze from the N.W. &
& L. at 6 Am cameled the watch and hoisting strong from the N.W.
and finished hoisting and all hands employed in Stowing Oil in the
fore hold and Sound these 24 hours and finished Stowing and Set
in by Clock 41:04 South And Long in 36:15. West

Monday January 25th These 24 hours Commences with a
gale of wind from the S.W. and a Ship insight to the west
ward & L. at 6 Am fired the foremast and blowing a
gale from the S.W. & L. at 6 Am Set the watch & L.
and middle part more moderate & L. at 6 Am cameled all
hands & L. Set the foremast but blowing strong
from S.W. and a Ship insight at 8 Am Set the
watch and latter part of these 24 hours more moderate and
Sound this Day and Set in by Clock 41:30 South
And Long In 36:05. West Long in & L.

Tuesday January 26th These 24 hours Commences with
light winds but a large Sea and thick Sail & L.
