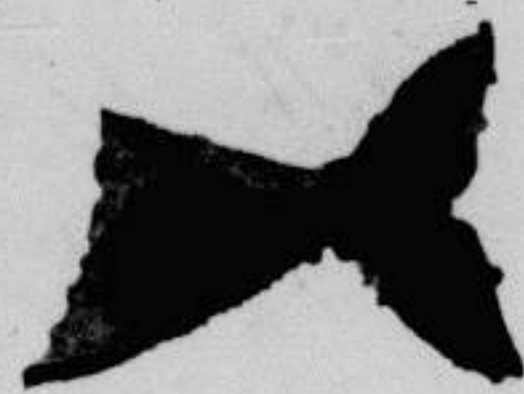
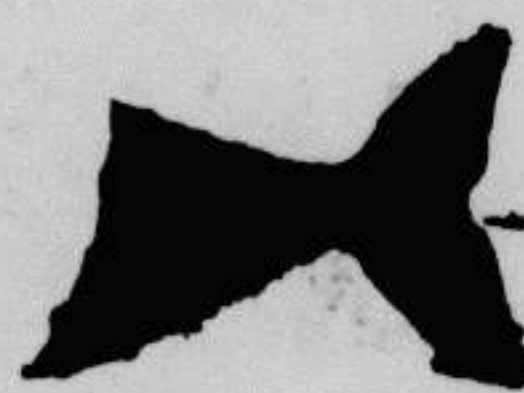


Friday 20th Sept 1833 Those 24 hours calm

And Edward of new London 4 Whales

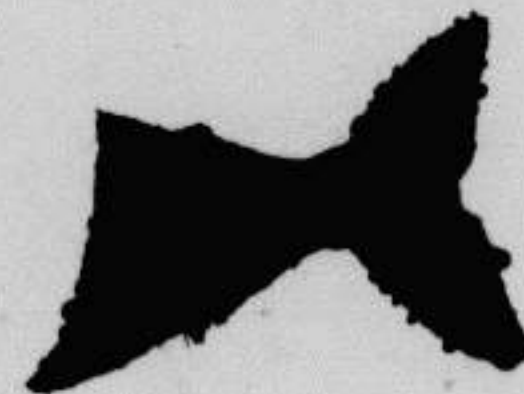


Saturday 21st Sept 1833 Those 24 hours begin
With strong breezes at 4 PM hove to saw
Ship george Porter off harbor quarters

Sunday 22^d Sept 1833 Those 24 hours
Begin with strong breezes middle and
Latter part moderate at 11 AM saw
Right whales did not get fast at 2 PM
Lowered our boats again did not get fast
Ship george Porter off Lee Bow. thus ends
Those 24 hours



Monday 23^d Sept 1833 All Those 24 hours light
Winds and pleasant weather at 11 AM Struck
A right Whale and stove Harbor Boat did
Not save him. at 1 PM Spoke Ship Millwood
Capt Taber of New Bedford so ends Those
24 hours.



Tuesday 24th Sept 1833 All Those 24 hours
Light winds and pleasant weather all hands
Employed in ship duty thus ends those
24 hours

Wednesday 25th Sept 1833 Those 24 hours
Begin with pleasant gales and clear
Weather so ends Those 24 hours

Thursday Sept 26th 1833 Those 24 hours pleasant
Gales and clear weather at 2 PM Killed
A Right Whale and cut him in so
Ends Those 24 hours



Friday Sept 27th 1833 Those 24 hours Squally
All Hands employed in Boiling oil. thus
Ends those 24 hours

Saturday Sept 28th 1833 Those 24 hours
Pleasant weather and strong Breezes this
Day finished Boiling oil so ends those 24
Hours

Sunday 29 Sept 1833 Those 24 hours Moderate
Breezes and pleasant weather. saw a Sulphur
Bottom Whale so Ends those 24 hours

Monday 30 Sept 1833 Those 24 hours pleasant
Gales at 10 AM Lowered our Boats after
A Whale did not get fast this Day sent
Aft fore and misen top J. Ballant yards so
Ends those 24 hours



Tuesday 1 Oct 1833 All Those 24 pleasant
Weather. saw a large number of fin back
Whales so ends Those 24 hours

Wednesday 2 Oct 1833 All Those 24 hours
Pleasant weather saw fin Back whales
At 12 AM Killed a porpoise so ends
Those 24 hours

Thursday 3 Oct 1833 Those 24 hours light winds
And pleasant weather so ends those 24 hours
