Equally lay to all those 24 hours

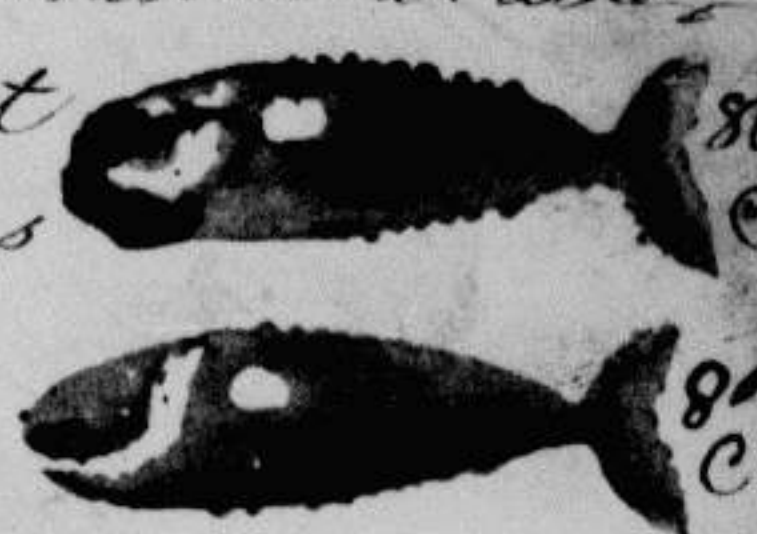
Monday 2 Decm 1833 Those 24 hours pleasant weather

Spoke a ship Philip Tall of Warren R.I.

At 8 AM Killed a whale to the Starboard Boat
At 4 PM Killed a whale to the Bow Boat
Ends those 24 hours

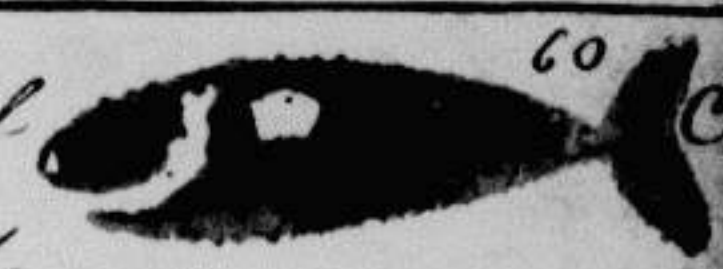


Friday 6 Decm 1833 Those 24 hours fine weather and

Ends Those 24 hours

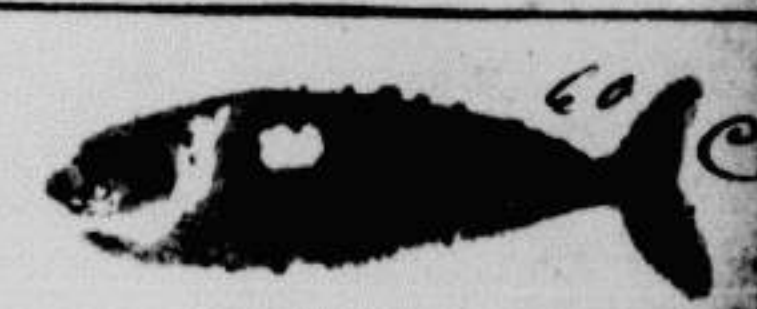
Saturday 7 Decm Those 24 hours Strong Breezes and cloudy

Sunday 8 Decm 1833 All Those 24 hours light breezes and clear

Saw a sail standing Westward so ends those 24 hours

Monday 9 Decm 1833 Those 24 Calm Weather and
Cloudy at 2 PM Killed a Whale to Starboard
Boat so ends those 24 hours
