Friday 25 July all those 24 hours strong breezes and
Clear weather laying off and on the harbour at 5
P.M. altered our course for the Cape of Good Hope so ends
those 24 hours

Saturday 26 July all those 24 hours pleasant breezes
and clear weather course S by W all hands employed
In Ship duty so ends those 24 hours

Sunday 27 July All those 24 hours Buggy Breezes and clear
Weather so ends those 24 hours

Monday 28 July Those 24 hours calm and rainy weather
All hands Employed on the rigging at 1 A.M. Saw a
Ship off Lee quarter standing southward at 2 P.M.
Saw 1 Ship and 1 Brig of Weather Beam

Tuesday July 29th All those 24 hours calm and rainy
Weather at 4 P.M. saw 2 Ships standing southward
so ends those 24 hours

Wednesday 30 July those 24 hours moderate breezes and
Clear weather saw 2 sail standing south all hands
Employed in ship duty so ends those 24 hours

Thursday 31 July Strong S.E. winds and cloudy weather
All hands employed in ship duty so ends those 24
hours

Friday August 1 All those 24 hours strong breezes and
Rainy weather so ends those 24 hours

Saturday August 2 All those 24 hours calm and clear
Weather all hands employed to work on rigging so ends
those 24 hours

Sunday 3^d August All those 24 hours calm and pleasant
Weather so ends those 24 hours

Monday 4 August Those 24 hours pleasant breezes
and Rainy weather so ends those 24 hours

Tuesday All those 24 hours strong breezes and
Clear weather at 11 A.M. saw a great number
of fin Back Whales all hands employed in
Ship duty
