Cloudy this day saw 3 ships and 1 Brig standing
W by E sharp in the wind our course N.B.E

Friday 8th August All those 24 hours strong breezes and
Clear weather saw 1 ship and 1 Brig of our lee bow
standing westward

Saturday 9th August those 24 hours calm weather saw
A Brig of our lee quarter all hands employed in
ship duty

Sunday 10th All those 24 hours calm and clear weather
Course sailed S.W. by South so ends those

Monday 11th those 24 hours strong breezes and clear
weather this day crossed the equinoctial line
Old Neptune came on board

Tuesday 12th All those 24 hours strong breezes
And clear weather all hands employed in
ship duty so ends those 24 hours

Wednesday 13 Calm and clear weather all hands
employed in ship duty course S.S.W. so ends those
24 hours

Thursday 14 August 1834 Calm and clear weather all
hands employed in ship duty so ends those 24 hours

Friday 15 August pleasant breezes and clear
weather at 4 P.M. saw a fin whale so ends those
24 hours

Saturday August 16th 1834 All those 24 hours strong
breezes and clear weather at 11 P.M. saw a ship
standing North

Sunday 17th August Those 24 hours pleasant breezes
And clear weather so ends those 24 hours

Monday 18th August Those 24 hours strong breezes and
Cloudy weather all hands employed in ship duty

Tuesday 19th August All those 24 hours strong breezes
And cloudy weather

Wednesday 20th August Those 24 hours begin with
strong breezes and cloudy weather all hands employed
in setting up rigging

Thursday 21st August Those 24 hours begin with
Calm weather and clear the watch employed in ship
duty

Friday 22nd August Those 24 hours begin with pleasant
breezes and cloudy weather the middle and latter
part the same at 4 P.M. Made the Island of
Aniwa so ends those 24 hours

Saturday 23rd August Those 24 hours begin with
Calm and clear weather middle part raining
latter clear Aniwa Island bears S.S.W. about
30 miles distant

Sunday 24th August 1834 All Those 24 hours
Pleasant breezes and clear weather saw
4 Whale ship of our lee quarter so ends those
24 hours
