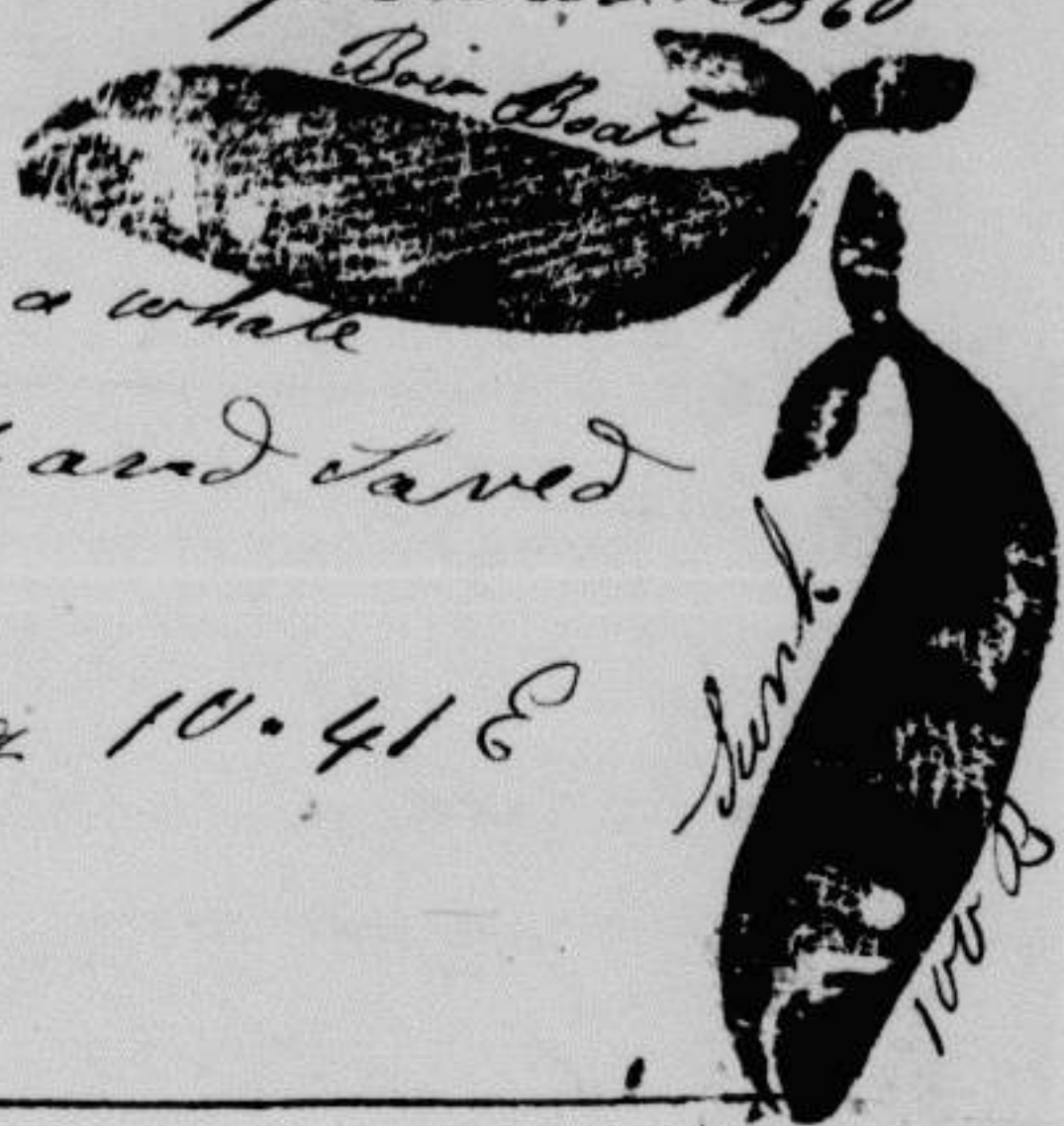


Tuesday 14th Oct 1834 All those 24 hours pleasant
Weather at 12 M Low our Boats
Starboard Boat struck and killed a whale
And sunk him Bow Boat killed and saved
one to ends those 24 hours

Lat 33° 05' S Long 10° 41' E

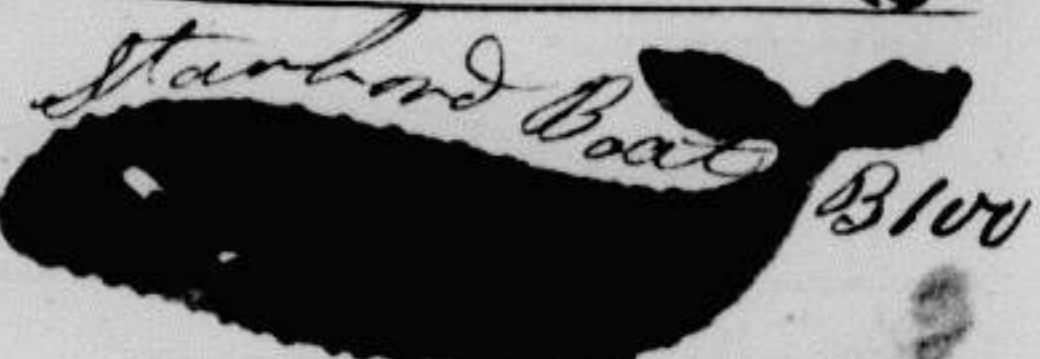


Wednesday 15 Oct 1834 All those 24 hours pleasant
Weather saw a number of whales could not get
fast 3 Ships in sight a boiling oil all hands
Employed in boiling oil and stowing down so ends
those 24 hours Lat 33° 05' S Long 10° 19' E

Thursday 16 Oct All those 24 hours pleasant weather
And clear at 10 AM Killed a whale to the
Starboard Boat and sunk him all hands employed
In stowing down oil so ends those 24 hours
Lat 33° 10' S Long 9° 56' E



Friday 17th Oct those 24 hours Starboard Boat
pleasant weather at 12 M Kill
A Whale to the Starboard boat Lat 33° 57' Long



Saturday 18th Oct those 24 hours strong breezes
At 10 AM Killed and sunk a whale saw a
Great number of whales could not get fast
Lat 33° 21' E



Sunday 19th Oct All those 24 hours heavy gales
All hands employed in boiling oil a number
Of ships in sight Lat 33° 13' S Long 9° 23' E

Monday 20 Oct 1834 All those 24 hours calm and
Clear weather lowered our boats a number of times
After whales could not get fast all hands employed
In stowing down oil so ends those 24 hours
Lat 33° 14' S Long 8° 57' E

Tuesday 21 Oct 1834 All those 24 hours pleasant
Weather chased whales all day could not get
fast 8 Ships in sight 3 a boiling oil
Lat 33° 20' S

Wednesday 22 Oct 1834 Strong breezes and rain
Chased whales all this day could not get fast
13 Ships in sight Lat 33° 10' S

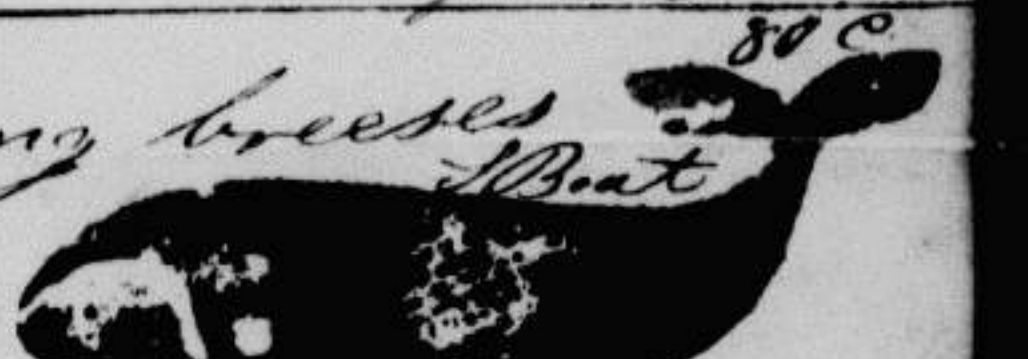
Thursday 23 Oct All this Day fine weather saw
14 Ships whales very wild Lat 34° 20' S Long 8° 1' E

Friday 24 All those 24 hours moderate breezes and
Clear weather 19 Ships in sight and 1 Boiling oil
Saw a plenty of whales could not get fast
Lat 33° 50' S Long 7° 50' E

Saturday 25 Oct those 24 hours moderate breezes
Breezes and clear at 12 M Killed a
Whale and cut him in saw a number of ships
Lat 33° 26' S Long 8° 49' E



Sunday 26 Oct those 24 hours strong breezes
And cloudy at 8 AM Killed a
Whale and cut him in at 12 AM Spoke Ship
Lucas (Capt Hempton with 1400 barrels oil at
4 PM Spoke Ship Sally Ann (Capt) of N Bedford
1400 whale 450 shearn so ends those 24 hours



Monday 27 Oct those 24 hours pleasant
Weather at 4 PM Killed a
Whale 12 Ships in sight so ends those 24 hours
Lat 33° 37' S



Tuesday 28 Oct those 24 hours strong breezes and
fairly lowered our Boats twice could not
Lust 4 Ships in sight
