And clear at 10 AM Spoke ship Royal William
Off St Johns NB with 1000 barrels oil
Lat 33.11 Long 7.10

Thursday those 24 hours heavy gales and raining
All hands employed in boiling and stowing
Down oil 2 Ships in sight so ends those 24
Hours Lat 32.35 Long

Friday 31 Oct 1834 those 24 hours heavy gales of
Wind and raining all hands employed in stowing
Down oil however our boats twice could not
get fast

Saturday 1st Nov 1834 those 24 hours strong breezes
At 2 PM Killed a whale to Starboard
Boat at 4 PM struck a whale and cut from
him after Dark so ends those 24 hours
Lat 33.00

Sunday 2nd Nov All those 24 hours calm
And clear at 7 AM Killed a whale
to Starboard Boat at 9 AM Killed
a whale to Starboard Boat 4 Ships in sight
Lat 33.03

Monday 3rd Nov 1834 All those 24 hours calm and clear
At 2 PM Killed a whale to the
Starboard Boat 2 Ships in sight plenty
Of whales Lat 32.53

Tuesday 4th Nov 1834 those 24 hours calm and clear all hands
Employed in stowing down and boiling oil 40 ships in
sight Lat 33.14

Wednesday 5th Nov 1834 those 24 hours
pleasant at 9 AM Killed a
Whale to Starboard Boat at 10 Killed a whale to
Starboard Boat and cut him in all hands employed
in stowing down oil so ends those 24 hours
Lat 33.03

Thursday 6th Nov 1834 those 24 hours calm and clear
Weather all hands employed in stowing down and
Boiling oil 14 Ships in sight 4 Boiling oil
Lat 33.00

Friday 7th Nov 1834 those 24 hours
Calm at 10 AM Killed 2 Whales
And cut them in 12 Ships in sight
Lat 32.57 Long 7.16

Saturday 8th Nov those 24 hours (1 Boat)
Calm and clear at 8 AM Killed
A Whale and cut him in 6 Ships in sight
Whales plenty Lat 33.01 1000 Barrells

Sunday 9th Nov those 24 hours strong breezes
And equally all hands stowing down oil
Night and day at 2 PM Spoke ship Sally Ann
Of New Bedford wanting 1 Whale
Lat 33.03

Monday 10th Nov those 24 hours strong breezes
And clear weather at 2 PM Spoke ship Sally
Ann of New Bedford wanting 1 whale Ship
Liverpool 1000 Barrells Lat 33.22 Long 7.30

Tuesday 11th Nov those 24 hours moderate breeze
And clear at 2 PM Spoke ship Com Decatur
Tally of New Bedford 2 whales Ship Martha
Potter 1000 Barrells oil all hands Boiling
And stowing down oil Lat 33.30 Long

Wednesday 12th Nov those 24 hours
Strong breezes and clear at 4
PM Killed a whale to Starboard Boat
All hands employed in stowing down oil
Lat 33.47 Long 7.56

Thursday 13th Nov All hands employed in
Boiling oil Lat
