Monday 15th 1834 these 24 hours strong breezes And foggy at 6 P.M. Spoke Ship Hope of N Bedford with 5 whales so ends

Tuesday 16th 1834 these 24 hours moderate Brees And clear saw 16 Ships at 12 P.M. Spoke Ship George Porter of New Bedford with 8 whales 80 Barrells Spear Lat 37.36 Long

Wednesday 17 Decm 1834 these 24 hours light winds And clear weather Spoke Ship George Porter of New Bedford with 8 whales 80 Barrells Spear so ends Lat 37.24 Long 4.21 W

Thursday 18th Decm 1834 all these 24 hours pleasant weather Spoke Ship Albion of Fairhaven with 13 Whales and ~~the~~ Barke Mary of St Johns N.D. with 13 Whales so ends Lat 37.25 Long 3.56 W

Friday 19th Decm All these 24 hours strong breezes and clear At 4 P.M. Killed a whale to S Boat and cut him in

Saturday 20 Decm All these 24 hours strong Breeses and clear at 11 A.M. Killed a whale and cut him in

Sunday 21 Decm These 24 begin with strong breezes And foggy all hands employed in stowing down Oil Saw the Barque Marys standing on the Wind saw the Ship Albion of Fairhaven Kill a Whale so ends

Monday 22 Decm All this 24 hours calm and Clear weather saw 2 Right whales could not get fast all hands employed in stowing Down oil Lat 37.48 Long 3.54 W

Tuesday 23 Decm 1834 All these 24 hours strong Breeses at 10 A.M. Killed a whale to Bow Boat and cut him in Larboard Boat struck a whale and the line parted so ends Lat 37.26 W

Wednesday 24th Decm 1834 All these 24 hours strong breezes and clear at 2 P.M. Killed a whale to S Boat and cut him in all hands employed in boiling oil & sheeps in sight so ends

Wednesday 25 Decm 1834 All these 24 hours strong breezes and clear weather At 12 o'clock Killed a whale to S Boat so ends Lat 40.13 Long 4.59 West

Friday 26 Decm These 24 hours begin with strong breezes Latter part moderate with fog all hands employed in Boiling oil so ends these 24 hours Lat 41.13 Long 4.37 W

Saturday 27th Decm these 24 hours begin with fresh breezes latter part foggy all hands employed in boiling and stowing down oil at 4 P.M. Spoke Ship Arrachella of Plymouth with 5 whales so ends

Sunday 28th Decm All these 24 hours light breezes And fine weather all hands employed in stowing Down oil so ends
