Setting from the N. E. to the S. W. Strong
At 11 AM Took the Main Top Gallant Sails
And Double Breezt the Top Sails. At Day Light
Saw 7 Reg of the Starboard beam. And made
Sail the latter part fine Latitude 35. 39 N

So Ends these 24 Hours

Remarks On Board Saturday February 13th 1860
These 24 hours commences with light breeze
At 9 AM Brok out for water. At 4 PM Saw
Sprouts of the Larkspur beam going quick. And
More of them the Middle. And the latter fine. In
Pleasant. At 10 PM. Towards. I. Boat. And got
A Sun fish. Latitude 36. 33 N. Strong S. W. by S
So Ends these 24 Hours

Remarks On Board Sunday February 14th 1860
The first part of these 24 hours fine. And
Light. At 1 PM. Saw. I. Boat. I. Boat.
Standing the same as the Sun. At 4 PM. At 4 PM
Put 1. Took the Top Gallant Sails it. Littered to
the South. At 5 PM. Double Breezt the Top Sails
And pulled the Main Sail. At 7 PM. Took the
Main. In. Took the fore sail. And the ship
At Day Light. Made ship. In. At the Top Sails
Double Breezt. In the fore. And Main Sails the latter
Part. Rainy. So Ends these 24 Hours

Shared. At 8 PM. S. So Ends these 24 Hours
