Remarks On Board When Day April the 5th 1850
These 24 hours commenced with a gale at 1st P.M.
Saw 1st large right whale its mors to ragged to
lower at 10 past 1st took in the fore sails and
set the main spruce. The wind is to the N.E.
At day lite made all sail with good weather. At 3 P.M.
Crewed out for water at 10 P.M. Saw right whales
The Leat. 44. 1. So ends these 24 hours

Remarks On Board When Day April the 6th
Commenced with good weather At 10 past 1st
Saw lowered 4 boats the whales were going
quick At 2nd came 1 boat At 4th past 1st saw
more whales at 4 P.M. lowered 3 boats the 1st boat
got fast the 2nd boat got fast and killed
the whale and he sunk the 3rd boat got
lapped the 1st boat lowered and took
the 2nd boat a long line the 3rd boat took
the line to the ship and took in 1st last
At 10 P.M. at day lite the captain went
off in the 1st boat and here to back up the 1st boat
The 1st boat got it. Then 1st boat got back first
The 1st boat lowered and took the line from the
ship. The 1st boat made sail then the 2nd B. and
the 3rd B. went off to try to get the 1st boat
The 1st boat not get it At 11 P.M. the 1st B. and
the 2nd B. came and heard the ship's horn
So the 1st B. and took her line to the ship.
And hauled on the line till we parted the
line. The 1st boat the whale and the 2nd B.
Line So ends these 24 hours Leat. 44. 10

Remarks On Board When Day April the 7th 1850
Commenced fine at 1st P.M. raised whales. It was first
the 1st boat the 2nd boat lowered and its name on
the main. And the 3rd boat called the 1st boat. I heard
At 2nd P.M. it broke away a little. I saw it
While about to the ship. The 1st B. and 2nd B. lowered
The 1st was of 10 minutes. The 3rd boat called them. I heard
And took in sail. And it set in for raising it.
At day lite set double reef top sails. The wind
blew too hard. At 1st P.M. at 1st P.M. saw ship. At 10

calm. At 1st P.M. saw right whales at 10. I saw lowered 4 boats
Leat. 44. 13. So ends these 24 hours

Commenced with a calm. At 1st P.M. got fast the
1st B. and 2nd B. the 3rd B. got fast to the same
Whales I killed them. I took them
In too get. I heard at 11. That night
Made the whales with fast. I took
In sail and got supper. I. At 1st P.M.
And the rest of the night in the 1st boat.
Set the main. At day lite pulled all
Hauls I commenced for cutting in
At 1st P.M. at 1st P.M. got ready
For cutting the Leat. 44. 3. At
So ends these 24 hours
