These 24 hours commences with good weather. The wind
blew the S. by E. to the E. at 5 pm. Set the fly
jib. The main top gallant sail. And more ships
The sunset took in sail for the night. At day lite
Main sail. The wind went to the S. by E. at 7 pm.
Sounded out 55 fathoms and were ship to the E. by
the light 4327 S. So ends these 24 hours

the S. at 1 pm. Saw right whails the were going
to the windward at 9 pm. Lowered 3 boats. At
sunset the came. I heard Dick not get fast
Seach in sail for the night. At day lite main sail
At 5 pm. Sounded out 65 fathoms. At 7 pm. Saw
a right whail. Lowered 3 boats the 11. boat
got fast. The 1. boat. And the 2. boat got fast
The 3. mate killed the whail. And he
sunk. And we hauled him up. got him
A long line. At 12. It was got dinner. In
commenced So ends these 24 hours

Remarks On Board Sun Day April the 21. 1850
These 24 hours commences with good weather. The
Wind is E. at 1 pm. got ready for cutting. At sunset
got the 1. boat. And took in sail and set the mack
gunster wacks. At day lite main sail. At 5. 9. m
Start the try works. At 4. past 9. I saw
some whails. Lowered 3 boats the 1. came
A board. At 12. It was with out getting
the light 4327 S. So ends these 24

The 11. boat. Stuck the 1. B. & B. boat
got fast the 11. boat. Lowered. And
killed him. At sunset. got him

And took in sail. and got supper
And set the wack. And started the
Hacks. At day lite got ready for cutting. At 7
pm. Sounded out the wacks. And commenced
cutting. in it was being punch. And I being
in running. At 12. It was got. Here got
dinner. So ends these 24 hours

Remarks On Board Tues Day April the 23. 1850
These 24 hours commences with a strong breeze
to the S. at 1 pm. Started the works
At sunset. Set the mack. by work.
Out for ducks and I have imployed setting
Wp. Shucks. I am trying. And is a heavy sea.
Running. So ends these 24 hours

Remarks On Board Wednes Day April the 24.
These 24 hours commences with a moderate
breeze to the S. by E. to the E. At 1 pm. I have
imployed setting up Shucks. And trying
At sunset. Set the mack. At 5. 9. m. finished
trying at day lite it was better than before
commenced setting down. So ends these 24 hours

Remarks On Board Thurs Day April the 25. 1850
These 24 hours commences with good weather. At 11
I have imployed setting down oil. At sunset. had
the wind was to the S. by E. to the E. At 1 pm.
At day lite main sail. At 5. 9. m. commenced
staying down the rest of the oil. At 11. hours
I have imployed. So ends these 24 hours
