Remarks the Board Sun Day January 9. 1831
 These 24 hours commenced fine the wind is S. by E.
 Steering S. by E. at 3. pm. started S. at
 sunset took in sail for the night Subble reef
 The top sails took in the jib an main sail and
 started at day lite called all hands main sail
 & fore sail to end this Day

Remarks the Board Sun Day January 10. 1831
 These 24 hours commenced with a moderate
 breeze from the S. W. Steering S. it was hard
 at 7 pm started S. by E. at 3 pm. said land
 off the S. by E. it was 400 islands we kept to
 the S. by E. and started for it at 3 pm we were
 up to it about 4. S. by E. D gave at sunset
 took in sail for the night put on a reef in the
 main an mizen top sails. Subble reef the fore top
 sail. started S. by E. the land bore N. W. by W.
 at 10 pm at day lite called all hands and set the jib
 & fore sail being a strong breeze from the N. by E.
 at 6 pm. took 3 boats for weight to take the L. B.
 got fast the S. by E. an W. B. got fast
 the miz. better ship got him along side at
 10 pm. W. hands was employed cutting in it was
 being to end this Day

Remarks the Board Sat. Day January 11
 These 24 hours commenced with a strong all
 hands employed cutting in finished at 5. pm
 at 6 pm were steep set the miz. and started
 the work it was rainy and blowing at 7 pm
 called the watch all hands were employed in
 boiling and setting up shanks it was
 being nasty day weather the
 Lat 40.30. S. to end this Day

W. A. Board The Ship Emma C. Jones of New Bedford Jan 9. 1831

Remarks the Board Sun Day January 12. 1831
 These 24 hours commenced with a strong breeze
 to the W. Steering to the S. at 2 pm set the
 Watch all hands were employed the tiller 3 pm at
 4 pm it began to rain hard at 5 pm
 & it cleared of blow very hard at 7 pm called
 the watch at 8 pm. finished boiling
 at 9 pm. watch went back to the other watch
 hands employed clearing up the deck at 10 pm
 laid sail set the fore an mizen top sail set
 & kept and set the jib to end this Day

Remarks the Board Mon Day January 13
 These 24 hours commenced with a strong breeze
 from the S. W. Steering to the S. an W. at
 7 pm took in all sail for the night it was
 blowing moderate gale all hands employed
 Steering down sail to end this Day

Remarks the Board Tues Day January 14
 These 24 hours commenced with a moderate
 gale all hands is employed steering down sail
 at 9 pm were steep set finished steering
 the sail. started at 10 pm. Left the Deck for
 provisions the wind S. by E. & very strong
 which called all hands at day lite main sail
 with Subble reef top sails and jib all hands is
 employed repairing provisions and steering
 finished at 7 pm. which the reef on top the
 mizen top sail set the main sail and mizen
 top gallant sail and fly jib mizen watch
 about 10 pm. the wind was S. by W. Steering
 to the W. at the Lat 40.40. S. Long 55. W.
 to end this Day
