Remarks On Board Sun Day January 21st 1854
 These 24 hours commences with a light breeze from the
 N.W. blowing to the S.W. and at 12 pm. brook and
 the water at 12 pm. the wind died away for 3 or 4
 minutes then commenced S.W. with a strong sea on
 through the ship. The water was all sail set the
 Watch is employed at ship's side to Ensign this Day
 the watch is of 12 men and 12 boats
 Remarks On Board Thurs Day January 22nd 1854
 These 24 hours commences fine the wind is W. with
 a strong sea. The water is employed at ship's side
 at 12 pm. took in all the light sail at Day
 the land and plenty of wright whales seen
 3 boats came to board at 12 pm. did not
 get past at 3 pm. saw 3 boats the L. B.
 got past and killed him the W. B. B. B.
 got past to him got him the long side at 12
 the Ensign this Day

 nothing in at 3 pm. the W. B. B. B. B. B.

 the watch is of 12 men and 12 boats

 a strong sea. The water is employed at ship's side
 at 12 pm. took in all the light sail at Day
 the land and plenty of wright whales seen
 3 boats came to board at 12 pm. did not
 get past at 3 pm. saw 3 boats the L. B.
 got past and killed him the W. B. B. B. B.
 got past to him got him the long side at 12
 the Ensign this Day

 employed nothing and sailing at sunset the land
 came to board and took in sail for the night
 at 12 pm. finished sailing the land is in site all
 the time at Day side called all hours it was dark
 and a strong breeze from the N.W. did not make
 going sail commencing strong down all hours is
 employed to Ensign this Day
