Remarks On Board Sat. Day April 5th 1831
 Breezy hours commences with fine weather, an light
 Breeze to the N. Steaming to the E. and the men
 employed at ships duty at sunset took in
 sail for the night and sounded 40 fathoms at
 Day Lites called all hands it was a foggy at 2 AM
 Main sail at 10 AM took in the main top gallant
 sail on fly get to Enders this Day

Remarks On Board Sun Day April 6th 1831
 Breezy hours commences with fog and a light
 Breeze to the E. Steaming to the S. and at 4 PM
 took in sail for the night at Day Lites called all
 hands main sail with single reef top sails at 2 AM
 took in the fore and main top sail on fly shallows
 the fore sail all breezy hours foggy and raining
 to Enders this Day

Remarks On Board Mon Day April 7th 1831
 Breezy hours commences with fog and a light
 Breeze to the E. Steaming to the S. and with Drizzle
 kept main top sail at sunset took in sail for
 the night and sounded 40 fathoms were ships at
 Day Lites called all hands main sail and wore ship
 Lites house on foggy all breezy hours the men
 were employed scraping the grass of the side
 to Enders this Day

Remarks On Board Tues Day April 8th 1831
 Breezy hours commences with fog and light
 Breeze to the E. Steaming to the S. and at sunset
 took in sail for the night and sounded 40 fathoms
 at Day Lites called all hands it was thick
 fog at 2 AM main sail light breezes and
 calm all breezy hours and foggy and
 to Enders this Day

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Remarks On Board Wednes Day April 9th 1831
 Breezy hours commences with a calm and foggy the
 men is employed scraping the ship at 4 PM took in
 sail for the night at sunset sounded 40 fathoms
 at Day Lites called all hands and at 10 AM
 took in the S. E. it was foggy at 2 AM it started
 Main sail stood the S. E. and at 3 PM
 standing two the S. and W. to Enders this Day

Remarks On Board Thurs Day April 10th 1831
 Breezy hours commences with a light Breeze to the
 S. E. Steaming to the S. and at 4 PM it came
 to the North took in all the Lites sails at sunset took
 in sail for the night at Day Lites called all hands
 it was a moderate gale snow and rain steering
 two the S. W. and at 2 AM main sail with bubble
 kept top sails at noon sounded 40 fathoms bottom
 to Enders this Day

Remarks On Board Fri Day April 11th 1831
 Breezy hours commences with a strong breeze
 from the S. Steaming to the S. and W. and
 at sunset took in sail for the night sounded
 40 fathoms at Day Lites called all
 hands and sail the latter part of the
 to Enders this Day

Remarks On Board Sat Day April 12th 1831
 Breezy hours commences with a strong breeze
 at sunset took in sail for the night at Day
 Lites called all hands it was blowing a
 moderate gale from the S. W. at 2 AM
 main sail with bubble kept top sails on
 fore sail at 4 PM past 10 AM squall struck us
 forced away the fore yard all hands were
 employed taking in sail and getting down
 the fore yard the squall lasted about
 twenty minutes the squall did away to
 a moderate gale
 to Enders this Day
