

Contract of Cornelius M. Marchant

& Samuel Osborn Jr. relating to Sale of ^{Part} of Scho.
"Emma Jane" for Bk of Brig E. H. Adams.

Whereas Samuel Osborn Jr. of Edgartown, Dukes County, Massachusetts, has this day sold to Cornelius M. Marchant, of said Edgartown, one eighth part of the Brig E. H. Adams, and outfit as she now is, and the said Marchant has this day sold to said Osborn one eighth part of the schooner "Emma Jane" and outfit as she sailed the 17th day of May last on her present voyage, it is hereby agreed, understood and acknowledged by and between the said parties, that said Marchant is owing said Osborn for his, said Marchant's share and interest in the outfit of said schooner on her last preceding voyage, Martin Master, and for his share of outfit of said schooner as she sailed on her present voyage, and said Osborn is owing said Marchant for his share of oil taken on her said last ^{preceding} voyage, Martin Master, and that said Marchant's share and interest in the oil obtained on her said last voyage preceding the present is to be credited to said Marchant by said Osborn on account of said indebtedness of said Marchant for outfit on said last preceding voyage of said schooner, as far as it will go, and that whatever said Marchant's share may be of insurance that may be obtained from the Atlantic Insurance Co. on said schooner on her said last preceding voyage, is also to be credited by said Osborn to said Marchant on account of said indebtedness for outfit on said last preceding voyage of said schooner; and whatever balance, if any on account of said last named outfit may be due said Osborn from said Marchant, as well as also said Marchant's share of the costs of outfit of the said schooner on her present voyage said Marchant is to pay said Osborn or be charged with by him in future settlement.
