

Remarks on Board Bark Endeavour

Monday Aug 2th

Came with Thick weather Ship at Anchor. Called all Hands at 3^o Am, and Lowered four Boats, at 9^o Am Cleared up about 40 Ships in Light, at 5^o Pm the Captain Come on Board and took the Anchor for they have got 2 whales in the ice, he got one and the waist Boat got the other and we got one of them along side at 6^o Pm and Commenced Cutting at 7^o Pm and got the other one along side at 9^o Pm got Supper and set the watch so ends

Tuesday Aug 3th

Came with Thick weather Ship under Short Sail, at 1^o Am Come to Anchor with 2 whales along side Called all Hands at 3^o Am and Commenced Cutting at 4^o Am in the afternoon lighted up a number of Ships in Light finished Cutting at 7^o Pm and set the watch so ends this Day

Wednesday Aug 4th

Came with Thick weather Ship at Anchor. Started the work at 6^o Am 2 Boats, Crew of the Ship Washington Come on Board, at 9^o Am Lowered the Larboard and Bow Boats, at 11^o Pm took the Anchor, the Boats Come on Board at 1^o Pm without success. Come to Anchor at 3^o Pm

Thursday Aug 5th

Came with fine weather with a little fog Ship at Anchor employed at Boiling at 5^o Am sent 3 Boats off, 2 Boats Crew of the Ship Condore Cowper and Dover Come on Board, for a while, the Larboard and Bow Boats Come on Board at 3^o Pm without success, a little ice and about 40 Ships in Light, the waist Boat Come on Board at 6^o Pm with out success saw 2 whales so ends this Day

Friday Aug 6th

Came with Thick weather Ship at Anchor employed at Boiling Called all Hand at 3^o Am and sent 2 Boats off they Come on Board at 9^o Am with out success, the Captain ^{Come on Board} of the Ship Maria Theresa ^{the got no} oil, about 20 Ships in Light so of them Boiling

Saturday August 7th

Came with Thick weather Ship at Anchor watch employed at Boiling in the afternoon lighted up some number of Ships in Light, some of them Boiling Captain Eldridge of the Bark Aragon Come on Board with no oil up hear

Sunday August 8th

Came with Thick weather at Different times Ship at Anchor employed at Boiling. Called all Hands at 4^o Am and Commenced Stowing Down oil, finished Boiling at 2^o Pm, number of Ship in Light and the Part Piece of ice in Light. Stowed Down 166 bls of oil, at 7^o Pm took the Anchor at 8^o Pm Come to Anchor so ends this Day all well

Monday August 9th

Came with Thick weather Ship at Anchor. Called all Hands at 5^o Am and took the Anchor and made Sail, and we Stowed Down 38 bls of oil, we Run of Hunter Bay through the Gut, and Come to Anchor at 11^o Am in Taylor Bay got the Deck, Cleared up by 5^o Pm and set the watch, Strong Breeze from the Northward

Tuesday August 10th

Came with the Ship at Anchor. Called all Hands at 4^o Am and took the Anchor and Run of the Bay all Hands employed at Scraping Bone we Run in the mouth of Mercury Bay and saw one Carcas. Run along the mouth of Potters Bay. So ends this Day

Wednesday August 11th

Came with fine weather and light Breeze from the S.W. Ship by the wind at 8^o Am off Hunter Gut at 9^o Am saw and Lowered for whales, at 11^o Am Come to Anchor in Calm, at 12^o noon light Breeze took the Anchor and Come through the Gut the Boats Come on Board at 3^o Pm with out success finished Scraping Bone and Smoked Ship and Come to Anchor at 6^o Pm in the Hunter Bay so ends this Day all well
