

Remark on Board Bark Endeavour

Monday Aug 30th

Came with ship at anchor all Hands employed at Stowing Down and Boiling Ships all got underweigh So ends

Tuesday August 31st

Came with fine weather ship at anchor employed at Boiling Captains Ashby and Morrison of the *Barndena* and Parker Wood Come on Board Rainier got 3¹/₂ bls flour out of us employed at Boiling So ends this Day

Wednesday Sept 1st

Came with fine weather ship at anchor Boiling at 6³⁰ Am Captain Steward of the Bark *Rajar* Come on Board and Captain Wilson gave him a order for 35 bls of oil employed at Stowing Down oil. So ends this Day

Thursday Sept 2nd

Came with Rain Stormy weather ship at anchor finished Boiling at 7³⁰ Am at 8³⁰ Am took the Anchor and stood N N E employed at Stowing Down oil at noon saw and lowered for whales and the Starboard Boat got one and we got him along side at 3³⁰ Pm and commenced Cutting at 6³⁰ Pm and finished Cutting at 9³⁰ Pm and Come to Anchor and let the watch

Friday Sept 3rd

Came with Stormy weather from the S E ship at anchor Called all Hands at 5³⁰ Am at 8³⁰ Am took the Anchor saw and lowered for whales and Mr Bradley of the *Starboard* Boat got one and we got him along side at 2³⁰ Pm got him Cut in at 5³⁰ Pm let the watch

Saturday Sept 4th

Came with thick weather and light air employed at Boiling at noon fine weather plenty of ships in sight oncor two of them Boiling Boats Crew of the Bark *Wagon* Come on Board she got 250 bls of oil this season at 6³⁰ Pm saw a Dead whale and we lowered the Starboard Boat for him and got him along side at 9³⁰ Pm and Come to Anchor and let the watch So ends this Day

Sunday Sept 5th

Came with good weather ship at anchor Called all Hands at 4³⁰ Am to Cut in the whale. employed at Boiling got the whale Cut in at 9³⁰ Am. the Captain went on Board of the ship *Tamul* Wood Come on Board at noon and took the Anchor and Run to Ficklestaff So ends this Day

Monday Sept 6th

Came with fine weather and light Breeze from the N W ship Bousing in Hunter Bay 10 or 12 ships in sight 2 of them Boiling spoke the ship L E Richmond & Whaler. Captain Wilson went on Board the Bark *Amazon* finished Boiling at 10³⁰ Pm So ends this Day

Tuesday Sept 7th

Came with fine weather and Brisk Breeze from the S E all Hands employed at Stowing Down oil at 11³⁰ Am spoke the L E Richmond the Captain Come on Board for a few Steering for Elbow Island and Come to Anchor at 7³⁰ Pm. 6 ships at anchor Stowed Down 111 bls of oil So ends

Wednesday Sept 8th

Came with fine weather ship at anchor under Elbow Island Called all Hands at 5³⁰ Am. took the Anchor with a light air the ship drifted close on the Rocks when we let go the Anchor at 9³⁰ Am took the Anchor and died away and we Come to Anchor at 10³⁰ Am. Captain Spencer of the Schooner E L Frost Come on Board she got 100 bls of oil at 4³⁰ Pm took the Anchor, all Hands employed at Brea Ring and Schoaks and Stowing Bone at 11³⁰ Pm Come to Anchor So ends this Day

Thursday Sept 9th

Came with fine weather ship at anchor at 2³⁰ Am light Breeze took the Anchor at 6³⁰ Am saw and lowered 2 different times for whales with out success. Clover Holden refused to do duty and struck the Mate. and the Captain put him in irons Down the River in the afternoon lowered for whales and the waist Boat got one and we got him along side at 9³⁰ Pm and Come to Anchor got supper and all Hands went below but one man So ends this Day
