

Remarks on Board Bark Endeavour

Sunday Oct 24th

Came with fine weather and light breeze from the Southward Ship Course E by N at 11^h Am wind from the SSE at 2^h Pm Blowing fresh from the SE took in the main Royal at 6^h Pm Blowing strong took in main top gallant sail Ship by the wind Heading ENE Cloudy weather at 7^h Pm Double Reefed the top sail. at 11^h Pm Blowing a Gale took in the fore top sail gillie fore sail and main sail Long 168.16 E

Monday Oct 25th

Came Cloudy weather and a Heavy Gale from the SE Ship under Close Reef main top sail fore topmast stay sail and main Spencer. at 8^h Blowing on took in the main top sail. Ship Heading NE at 11^h Am Heavy Rain squalls. at noon Moderated set the main top sail Close Reefed and set the fore sail. at 3^h Pm wind hauled to the Southward made sail Ship Heading E by N at 11^h Pm wind from SSE Blowing fresh took in sail to Close Reef main top sail fore topmast stay sail and main Spencer So ends this Day no Observation.

Tuesday Oct 26th

Came with Rain Stormy weather from the SE Ship under Close Reef main top sail. at 8^h Am wind light made sail at 10^h Am wind hauled to the NW and NNW made all sail. at 11^h Am Blowing Strong Ship Course E by S. at 4^h Pm Blowing Heavy took in sail to Double Reef top sail. Scudding before the wind with a Heavy sea So ends this Day

Wednesday Oct 27th

Came with Rain Stormy weather Ship under Double Reef top sail wind from the Westward Ship Course E by S. at 10^h Am Moderated made all sail at noon fine weather with light Rain squalls set the main Royal at 8^h Pm Carried away the topmast Studding sail Boom So ends this Day

Came with Rain Squally weather and light breeze from the westward Ship Course E by S. all sail set in the afternoon wind hauled to the NW watch employed at Ship Duty Lat 47.20 N Long 177.37 E

Friday Oct 29th

Came with Cloudy weather and Moderate breeze from the NW all sail set Ship Course E by S. at 5^h Am Strong breeze with Heavy Rain squalls from the Northward took in Studding sail and main top gallant sail. at 10^h Am Moderated made all sail So ends this Day

Friday Oct 29th

Came with Cloudy weather and light breeze from the SE Ship by the wind Heading ENE watch employed at Ship's Duty. Saw some fine birds no observation to Day at 10^h Pm Blowing strong from the Eastward took in sail to Double Reef top sail at 11^h Pm took in the fore top sail So ends this

Saturday Oct 30th

Came with Strong Gale and Rainy weather from the Eastward Ship by the wind Heading SSE and SE by S. Put Thomas Care one of the Boat Steerer in iron for disobeying orders Ship under Close Reef main top sail fore sail and main Spencer and fore topmast stay sail at 10^h Pm Blowing on took in the main top sail and fore sail So ends

Sunday Oct 31th

Came with Rain Stormy weather with a Strong Gale from the ENE Ship by the wind Heading SSE at 9^h Am Moderated made sail wind NE in the afternoon wind NNE Ship Course ESE all sail set Lat 46.36 N Long 176.59 W

Monday November 1st

Came with fine weather and light breeze from S to SE Ship by the wind Heading E by S and ENE all sail set watch employed at Ship's Duty took Thomas Care out of iron Lat 46.35 N Long 175.09 W
