

Remarks on Board Bark Endeavour

Sunday Nov 14th

Came with fine weather and light Breeze from S. S. E. to S. S. W. Ship by the wind heading E. S. E. and E. by N. we bent a New fore Sail and main top Gallant Sail one Sail in light. at 4th Pm Captain Wilson went on Board of her. She proved to be the Ship Charles Phelps of New London with 1300 bbls of oil this Season Bound to the Sandwich Island at 11th Pm wind light with Rain squalls. Lat 29.54 N Long 154.26 W

Monday Nov 15th

Came with Rain Squally weather with light Breezing Breeze from all Points of the Compass with Thunder and lightning at 4th Pm light Breeze from the Eastward Ship's Course S. by E. and E. sent up the fore top Gallant mast one Sail in light. Telt out Malafres no Observation

Tuesday Nov 16th

Came with Squally weather and light Breeze from E to S. E. Ship by the wind heading S. S. W. and S. by W. at 8th Am Strong Breeze and fine weather from E. S. E. Ship's Head S. by W. watch employed at washing Bone so ends this Day

Wednesday Nov 17th

Came with fine weather and light Breeze from the E. S. E. Ship by the wind heading S. by W. all Hands employed at washing Bone and sending out a fly jib. Boon and sent up fore top Gallant yard and set the Sails.

at 3th Pm Wind Hauled E Ship's Head S. by E. and S. S. E.

Came with fine weather and light Breeze from the Eastward Ship by the wind heading S. by E. at 9th Am Strong Breeze from E. N. E. Ship's Course S. S. E. watch employed at washing Bone in the afternoon all Hands washing Bone at 6th Pm wind N. E. Ship's Course S. E. by S. N. S. Lat 24.25 N Long 156.09 W

Friday Nov 19th

Came with fine weather and Strong Breeze from the Eastward Ship's Course S. by E. at 10th Am Squally weather all Hands employed at washing and finished washing Bone and washed Ship and got the Chains up and the Anchor off the Bore in the afternoon Ship's Course S. S. W. one of the Sick men came on Duty so ends this Day

Saturday Nov 20th

Came with fine weather and Strong Breeze from the Eastward Ship by the wind on both Tack. at Day light Steering S. by W. at 6th Am Moon in light at 9th Am Mars in light at noon Rain in light at 5th Pm Came to Anchor at Lahaia 17 Ships Lay at Anchor got off some Beef and Palatos so ends this Day all well but one man Ship at Lahaia

Sunday Nov 21th

Fine weather all Hands employed doing Nothing one Ship arrived at off some Beef and had Plenty of Cyperney so ends this

Monday Nov 22th

Fine weather all Hands employed at Draping and Bundling Bone and putting on Board of the Ship Anglo Saxon so ends

Tuesday Nov 23th

Fine weather all Hands employed at Draping and Bundling Bone and we finished Bundling and put it on Board of the Anglo Saxon in all 143.56 lbs by 5th Pm hove up to Anchor and Hauled Close to the Anglo Saxon for the purpose of Shipping the oil. the Second Mate M^r Trelove has been on Shore for two days on a Drunk he came off to get when he was in the Boat two different Times

Wednesday Nov 24th

Fine weather all Hands employed at Breaking out oil and putting it on Board the Ship Anglo Saxon

Thursday Nov 25th

Fine weather all Hands employed at Breaking out and Shipping oil on Board the Ship Anglo Saxon so ends this Day
