Remarks on Board Bark Endeavour
Friday Nov 26th

fine weather all Hands employed at Breaking out and
Shipping oil on Board of the Ship Anglo Saxon so ends this Day

Saturday Nov 27th

fine weather all Hands employed at getting off water and
Stowing it Down at 5⁰⁰ Pm Rain Squally weather

Sunday Nov 28th

fine weather all Hands but 4 went on Liberty

Monday Nov 29th

fine weather all Hands employed Lifting up Shooks
getting off water and Stowing it Down so ends this

Tuesday Nov 30th

fine weather all Hands employed at Breaking out and
Shipping oil on Board of the Ship Anglo Saxon so ends this

Wednesday December 1st

fine weather all Hands but 3 employed at Breaking
out and Shipping oil on Board of the Ship Anglo Saxon
the 3 men went on Liberty we shipped on Board the
Anglo Saxon 750 bbls of oil and 35 bbls of oil
belonging to the Bark Rajah in the afternoon
Strong Breeze with Rain Squalls from the Southward

Thursday December 2nd

fine weather all Hands employed at Breaking out and Stowing
off the after Hole and Lifting up Shooks and got off 24
Barrels of Potatoes Oil Remaining on Board 225 bbls

Friday December 3rd

fine weather the Starboard watch went on Liberty

Saturday December 4th

the Larboard watch went on Liberty and we got
off our Provisions the Ship Anglo Saxon Cleared

Sunday December 5th

fine weather all Hands but 4 went on Liberty

Monday December 6th

fine weather Calm all Hands 5⁰⁰ Am sent 3 of the
Bark Rajah to do Duty and the Larboard watch
them in Irons and sent a Shore party to the
Bark Rajah and he put 2 of them in the
Bark Rajah 7 men and the Cook Refused to do Duty and
he could come ashore and we put them in Irons and bore
the main top sail shot through their arms, except the
cock, so ends this Day got off one Raft water

Tuesday December 7th

fine weather employed at Stowing Down water and
sent a Raft a Shore the Sheriff came off and took 2
of the men a Shore and put them in the port in Irons

Wednesday December 8th

fine weather employed at getting off water and
Stowing it Down and Painting Ship out side and we
got off some Fruit for watch we gave oil we Discharged
Mr Ashby the Mate and the sick man Hurry

Thursday December 9th

fine weather employed at Painting Ship and Clearing up
Cocks and Discharged 2 Boat Steers clever Holden and
Freit, and 2 of the men in Irons went on Duty

Friday December 10th

fine weather employed getting the Ship Ready for sea and
we got off 15 bbls of Potatoes and shipped a Cook and
took Peter the Boat Steer out of Irons and one of the men
out of Irons to do Duty

Saturday December 11th

fine weather Fine Breeze and started Home the top sail
at 2⁰⁰ Pm the 2 men in the port came on Board in Irons
and the Captain and 2 Passengers came on Board at 3⁰⁰ Pm
took the Anchor and made sail for Honolulu with
a light Breeze from the westward so ends this Day
