

Remarks on Board Bark Endeavour

Monday Jan 17th

Came with fine hot weather the Starboard watch went on Liberty, and we got off some wood and water a number of females Natives Come on Board for the first time for 20 years So ends this Day

Tuesday Jan 18th

Came with fine weather and the Starboard watch on Liberty got off wood water and fruits

Wednesday Jan 19th

Came with Rain Squally weather at 6^o Am fine weather and Strong Breeze from S E the Starboard watch went on Liberty got off wood water and fruits So ends this Day

Thursday Jan 20th

Came with fine weather and we took our Anchor and Drifted Down the Bay and Came to Anchor and the Starboard watch went on Liberty the Cooper and Cook Deserted So ends this Day

Friday Jan 21st

Came with fine weather took our Anchor and went to Sea So ends this Day

Saturday Jan 22nd

Came with fine weather and light Breeze at 6^o Am Towed for Spurr cables without Success the Land in Sight all Day Ship Laying off and on the Island

Monday Jan 23rd

Came with fine weather with light Rain Shower Ship Standing in Shore at 9^o Am the Captain went a Shore for the Deserters and he found them he had to give 10 Dollars and a Keg of Powder for them the Cooper got in the Boat as he was ordered but the Cook Refused and he Struck the Captain when they got on Board the Captain put him in the Rigging and give him 48 Lashes. Made all Sail Steering S E wind from the Northward one Sail in Sight Squally weather

Came with Squally weather from the Northward Ship Course S E at 6^o Am fine weather and light Breeze from N to N E watch employed at Ship Duty at 3^o Pm Steering S E all Sail Set So ends this Day

Wednesday Jan 26th

Came with Rain Squally weather from N N E to N E Ship Course S E at 7^o Am fine weather and light Breeze watch employed at Ship Duty So ends this

Thursday Jan 27th

Came with fine hot weather and light Breeze from the Eastward Ship Course S S W took in the Bow Boat to mend watch employed at Ship Duty

Lat 19.31 S

Long 171.29 W

Friday Jan 28th

Came with fine weather and light Breeze from the Eastward Ship Course S S W and S W by S watch employed at Ship Duty mended the Bow Boat and Painted her all Sail Set So ends this Day

Lat 22 00 S

Long 172.57 W

Saturday Jan 29th

Came with fine weather and light Breeze from the Eastward Ship Course S W by S watch employed at Ship Duty mended the Stoven Boat So ends

Lat 23.35 S

Long 174.14 W

Sunday Jan 30th

Came with fine weather and light Breeze from the N E Ship Course S W by S all Sail Set

Lat 24.24 S

Long 175.27 W

Monday Jan 31st

Came with fine weather and light Breeze from the N E Ship Course S W by S all Sail Set watch employed at Ship Duty Killed 2 Pigs mended the fore top mast Stayed in the afternoon light air from the Northward So ends this Day

Lat 25.47 S

Long 176.27 W
