Tuesday Feb 1st

Came with fine weather and light Breeze from the N^W Ship Course S^W by S. watch employed at Painting Boats in the afternoon Rain Squally weather from N^W to S. S. E. Ship by the wind Heads S^W. Saw some fampers and Sunday Island in sight on the weather Bow Bearing about S. Distance about 25.00 Lat 27.00 S. Long 177.42 W.

Wednesday Feb 2nd

Came with fine weather and light Breeze from the S. E. Ship by the wind Heading S^W and S^W by S. watch employed at Painting Boats in the afternoon Calm Killed 6 Hogs Saw some fampers so ends this Lat 27.45 S. Long 178.44 W.

Thursday Feb 3rd

Came with fine weather and light Breeze from N to N^W Ship Course S^W by S. watch employed at Painting Boats and we Killed 4 Hogs at Saw and Lowered for whales with out success at 4 Pm fine Breeze from the W. Lat 28.40 S. Long 179.53 W.

Friday Feb 4th

Came with Rain Squally weather with a Strong Breeze from S. E. to E Ship Course S^W by W. all Sail Set watch employed at Ship's Duty so ends

Saturday Feb 5th

Came with Rain Squally weather and Strong Breeze from the E. S. E. Ship Course S^W all Sail Set watch employed at washing Ship all day. in the afternoon wind Hauled to S. E. with fine weather so ends this Day Killed 2 Pigs Lat 32.13 S. Long 176.04 E.

B. C. Wilson Master February 1859
Sunday Feb 6th

Came with fine weather and Strong Breeze from S^W Ship by the wind Heads S. S. E. and W. N. W. on both sides so ends this Day one Pig Died Lat 32.21 S. Long 175.21 E.

Monday Feb 7th

Came with fine weather and light Breeze from the S. E. Ship by the wind Heads S^W by W. watch employed at Painting Boats Cleaning Spads and whitewashing the Trypworts. one Sail in sight on the Starboard Beam Lat 32.31 S. Long 174.20 E.

Tuesday Feb 8th

Came with fine weather and light Breeze from the S. W. Ship by the wind Heads S. S. E. watch employed at Ship's Duty. Killed 3 Hogs so ends this Day Lat 32.47 S. Long 174.30 E.

Wednesday Feb 9th

Came with fine weather and light Breeze from the S. to S. S. W. Ship by the wind on both Tacks Heads W. S. W. and W. and S. E. watch employed at Ship's Duty Lat 33.11 S. Long 174.20 E.

Thursday Feb 10th

Came with fine weather and light air and Calm from the Eastward. Ship Course S. S. W. in the afternoon light Breeze at 4 Pm Saw and Lowered for sperm whales and the Bow Boat struck one and the hick. Dressed and we lost him. S. at sundown the Island of Mangrove in sight bearing S. S. W. Distance about 20 Miles so ends Lat 33.33 S. Long 173.56 E.

Friday Feb 11th

Came with fine weather and light Breeze from S. W. Ship by the wind Heads S. S. E. and W. N. W. in both Tacks at 8 Pm Strong Breeze watch employed at mending Sail Lat 34.18 S. Long 174.24 E.
