Comes with fine weather and Moderate Breeze from the Eastward Ship by the wind on both Tacks at Daylight Present Island Distance about 5 Miles at 9th Am the Natives Come off and 3 white men Come off and we lay off and on all Day and we got off 50 Ship and about 3000 Coconuts one of the Boat Steerer got Drunk on Shore and when he Come on Board he got Disorderly and the Captain put him in Irons and whist him Down on Deck at 8th Pm made Sail Steering NE Bound to the North so ends this Day

Thursday March 24th

Comes with fine weather and light Breeze from the Eastward Ship Course NNE watch employed at Ship Duty killed five Hogs at 5th Pm Rain Equally weather from all Points of the Compass
