Wednesday April 6th

Came with fine weather and light Breeze from the E Ship. Laying off and on at 10^o Am the Captain Come on Board with Captain Andrews. Sold 100 lbs of Bread four Sacks of Potatoes 50 lbs Currants and some medicine and they went shore again with the Mate and Third Mate Down to the Harbour to a Ball. There is on Board the Russian Ship, in the afternoon Rain slightly west.

Thursday April 7th

Came with fine weather and Moderate Breeze from NE Ship. Laying off and on at 10^o Am the Mate his Brother and a Mr Gibson Come off and they all went a Shore again at noon and the Boat Come off at 5^o Pm with some Sweet Potatoes and one of the men Come off Drunk. Captain and Mate a Shore. Ship Laying off and on so ends the

Friday April 8th

Came with fine weather and light Breeze from the NE Ship. Laying off and on at noon Lent in a Boat and at 2^o Pm the Mate Come off at 3^o Pm Lent in a Boat and the Captain Come off at 4^o Pm. Made Sail and Run Down to the Harbour and at 5^o Pm the Captain went on Board of one of the Ships in the Harbour we Shipped Two men. Native of the Sandwich Islands. Ship Lay off and on at 7^o Pm Captain Come on Board Made Sail Steering N. Bound for the Ochotsk

Saturday April 9th

Came with fine weather and Strong Breeze from the Eastward Ship Course N all Sail Set so ends

Sunday April 10th

Came with fine weather and Moderate Breeze from the Eastward Ship Course N all Sail Set Lat 18 00 N.

Came with Rain slightly weather from the Eastward Ship Course N at 8^o Am fine weather and Brisk Breeze Lat 20.21 N

Came with fine weather and light Breeze from the NE Ship by the wind Head N N W and N by W. Lent Down to fore top Sail to mend and we lent it up again at 6^o Pm and let it.

Came with slightly weather at 3^o Am fine weather and light Breeze from NE Ship by the wind Head N N W at 9^o Am wind E by S Ship Course N N E watch employed at mending Sail Ned Come on Duty after being on the sick List 4 months with the Laidly fever Killed one Hog so ends Lat 23 00 N.

Thursday April 14th

Came with fine weather and Brisk Breeze from the Eastward Ship by the wind Head N by W and N N E watch employed at mending Sail so ends this Day Lat 23 41 N

Friday April 15th

Came with fine weather and Strong Breeze from the Eastward Ship by the wind Head N N E watch employed at Ship's Duty so ends this Day Lat 25 13 N.

Saturday April 16th

Came with fine weather and Strong Breeze from the SE Ship Course N N E all Sail Set saw some hump and fin Backs and Sulphur bottoms so ends Lat 27 28 N.

Sunday April 17th

Came with fine weather and Strong Breeze from S to W. Ship's Course N N E and N by E & E all Sail Set saw some Hump and fin Backs so ends this Day Lat 30 00 N.
