Sunday Feb 12th

Came with all Hand, getting off one Bullock
at 3^o Pm took our Anchor with a light Breeze
from the S.W. at 4^o Pm got out Side of the
Reef Ship by the wind Heading N.W. by W
Left the Bark, Cavalier and Indian Queen
at Anchor So ends this Day Ship at Sea

Monday Feb 13th

Came with fine weather and strong Breeze
from the S.E. Ship's Course W.S.W. So ends this
Lat 24.50 S. Long 41.95 E

Tuesday Feb 14th

Came with fine weather and light Breeze
from the S.E. Steering W.S.W. employed at
Mending Sail at 4^o Pm Lowered for Case fish
with out Success. Lat 26.07 S

Wednesday Feb 15th

Came with fine weather and light Breeze
from the S.E. Ship's Course S.W. by W. in W
Lat 27.18 S. Long 36.53 E

Thursday Feb 16th

Came with fine weather and strong Breeze from
the S.E. Ship's Course W.S.W. all sail set So ends
Lat 29.23 S. Long 35.40 E

Friday Feb 17th

Came with fine weather and strong Breeze
from the E.N.E. Ship's Course W. by S. at 5^o Pm
Lowered for Spurrin whales and they proved
to be Grampuses with out Success So ends
Lat 31.27 S. Long 34.10 E

Saturday Feb 18th

Came with fine weather and light Breeze
from the N.E. Ship's Course W. by S. at 10^o Am
wind Hauled to the S.W. with Rain, Ship
by the wind Heading N.W. by W at noon
fine weather all sail set. one sail in light
Lat 32.20 S. Long 32.12 E

Came with fine weather and light Breeze
from the S.W. Ship by the wind Heading N.W.
at 5^o Pm Lowered for Spurrin whales with out
Success at Sundown the Land in light So ends
Lat 31.55 S. Long 31.16 E

Monday Feb 20th

Came with fine weather and light Breeze from
the Eastward Ship's Course W. by S. at 4^o Am strong
Breeze water employed at Ship Duty at 6^o Pm
wind Hauled to N.W. Ship by the wind Head
W.S.W. with Rain So ends this Day
Lat 32.48 S. Long 29.14 E

Tuesday Feb 21st

Came with strong Breeze and heavy Squally
weather from the S.W. Ship under fore top
mast stay sail main and Mizzen stay sail
at 8^o Am Moderated made sail. in the
afternoon light Breeze set top gallant sail
the Land and one sail in light no Observing

Wednesday Feb 22nd

Came with fine weather and light Breeze from
the S.W. to W.S.W. Ship by the wind Head N.W. by
W and S.E. at Sundown Land bearing N.W. by
to N.N.E. Distance about 10 Miles. light air
Lat 33.30 S. Long 27.29 E

Thursday Feb 23rd

Came with fine weather and light air and Calm
at 8^o Am light Breeze from the S.W. to W.S.W.
Ship by the wind on both Tacks Heading W.N.W.
S.E. Land Close too 3 sails in light So ends
Lat 34.00 S. Long 26.12 E

Friday Feb 24th

Came with Squally weather and strong Breeze
from the westward Ship by the wind on both
Tacks under Double Reef top sails Cape Reef
light in light. at 6^o Pm moderated made sail.
Lat 34.16 S. Long 25.45
