1849

Monday 12
From strong winds from
S.W. W. Course 6
at hole main to sail quite clear
and watch inflat in ship duty

Midle port strong winds from
S.W. thick & rainy took in
light sails at 11 AM doubled
next to sails later ditto
To ends thick & stormy

Lat by Dr 39.56 Long by Dr 53.40

Tuesday 13 Strong winds from S.W.
Course 6 at 3 PM blowing hard with
squalls took in the fore & main to
sail last next the main course 6 by
raining smoothly

Midle port more moderate make
sail winds N.W. thick with rain

Later port winds 6 N.E. onto stack
thick & rainy

Lat by Dr 39.30 Long by Dr 57.40

Wednesday 14 Light rain from S.E. on
the stack thick weather at sunset
Calms heavy swell from S.W.

Midle port fine winds from
S.W. Course 6 by

Later ditto Lat 39.21 Long 48.49

Monday 15
Fine breeze from S.W.
Course 6 by all sail last at sunset
doubled next to sails thick strong
breeze

at 8 AM saw sperm whales at 9 AM
saw four at 10 AM struck out at
10 1/2 turned him up to windward

Later port fine weather employed in
working ship up to whail

To ends Lat 39.34 Long

Tuesday 16 fine winds from S.W.
employed in working ship up to whail
at 2 PM took the whail long side
at 3 commenced cutting at 7 finished
cutting then doubled next to top sails
hading to N.W. W. 1/2 half watches
employed in cleaning up decks

Midle & Later port strong winds from
N.W. W. with rain all hands employed
in cleaning away hader

Lat 39.55 Long 45.47

Wednesday 17 Strong winds from N.E.
thick & squally at 4 PM all cleared up
then last next to top sails steering
6 S.E. 6 squalls of rain

Midle & Later port strong gales from
N.W. W. steering 6 S.E. under close reef
main to sail & pursue

Lat 39.34 Long 42.45
