Light breeze from E S E by the wind
all hands employed in sending out
boom at 2 PM sent the ship then employed
in looking out after hatch at 4 PM finished
having S. S. W

Middle & Later part Light breeze
from E with heavy rain

Lat 22.21 Long 26.53

Monday 5 Light breeze from E
S E to N E course & thick with squalls
of rain

Middle part Light breeze from E
all watch cheerfully employed

Later part fine breeze from E

Lat 20.44 Long 26.38

Tuesday 6 Fine breeze from E
course S by E at sunset wind
lightening aft hauls in the middle
course

Middle part Fine N E trades

Later part Weather the same

Lat 18.24 Long 25.35

Wednesday 7 Fine N E trades course
all sail out 2 sail in situ 1 steering S by W
the other steering N. S. W

at 11 in the evening saw St. Anton at 2.
Port it

Later part calms at 9 AM saw &
sawd for blackfish got 2 of Meniscus fish
then to the ship and then in Lat 16.36 Long 25.20
