Friday 24th. Strong winds from  
S.E. standing. The snow falling fast all hands  
ring logs in snow hauling.

Middle Moderate gales from S.E.  
thick rainy and cold lying on the  
stack.

Late Much the same

Saturday 25th. Moderate gales from  
S.E. lying on the stack at 6 PM took  
in the foresail thick rainy and cold.  
Middle Snowing and blowing.  
Late wore ship to S.E. North on  
rainy.

Lat 58.20 Long 175.00

Baromet. 29.4/10

Sunday 26th. It fell more moderate  
and ship to S.W. Double reef top sails.

Middle Thick weather with snow  
and fog at 9 PM took ship to S.E.

Late thick with snow strong winds

Lat 60.48 Long 174.10

Baromet. 29.5/10

Lat 59.40 Long 175.30

Monday 27 Strong winds from N.E.  
thick snow storm on the stack  
at 7 PM double reef top sails  
the sun sets at 10 o'clock and rises at  
3 in the morning.

Middle Strong winds from N.E. on the  
stack.

Late Thick fog. No obs to day.

Tuesday 28 Winds N.E. thick fog  
standing to S.E. this fore seems  
dismal thick dark weather fog all  
the time. Have had only 1 clear day since  
left the Lat. 45. Have seen the sun  
but a very few times I hardly know  
where I am and where I am going to.  
I am completely shut up in thick fog  
can't see the length of the ship  
I must go out with a clear ship.

Middle blowing a heavy gale from N.E.  
lying on the stack under close reef. Main  
top sail snowing and cold can  
be cold met.

Late Much the same

No obs to day. Baromet. 28.5/10

Wednesday 29 Heavy gales from  
N.E. lying under close reef. Main  
top sail snowing and blowing hard.  
Dark weather. Never a few minutes.

Middle and late Much the  
same thick and dark weather.
