

Enterprise in the ice June 4th 1850

At 10 AM saw a bookee going quick
Load in company with Jent Chabbe
but to no purpose Chabbe him untill she
ice boat us up Stument on board
Left Tabor on board of the Enterprise

Lat port quite clear area very smooth
striking from N.W. to N.E. the ice
is thick. No cracks

My Lat by a poor obs 62° 00' Long 179° 55' W
Baromet 29.6/10

Thursday 4th Light breeze from S.
striking to N. in company with Juleon
at 7 PM found an open sea left
to for the night

Middle during N.W. at 6 AM saw the canoe
could see St. Thaddeus 5 ships in site all
cutting on boyling

Lat fine winds from S. ice quite
clear No obs Baromet 29.7/10

Friday 5th Fine winds from
S standing in for the canoe 5 ships
in site the Juleon & Stent at 12 PM
saw and heard for bookee No such things
at 5 PM saw and heard a gain
at 7 struck him then commenced towing
at 9 took him to the ship quite calm
at 11 commenced cutting but 3 in the
morning finished cutting No 1

Middle and later fine weather light
breeze all round compass employed
in paying Main yard a back
board M. Legue dit Baromet 29.9/10

Thursday 6th Light breeze from S. standing
in for the Cape 13 ships in site all cutting
on boyling Sept 2nd at 12 Sat try watched
hulling in for the Land in hopes to gain an
other bookee

Middle and later thick fog one watch
employed in boyling Baromet 29.1/10

Friday 7th Winds S.S.E. standing in
on the canoe saw twice for whales
but to no purpose at 7 PM strong
breeze took in for and Mizzen top
ail boyling

Middle and later moderate light in
boyling Lat 63° 05' Long 179° 20'

Saturday 8th Fine weather
light from N. Load for bookee
No such things at 4 PM finished boyling
1.10 lbs. then commenced breaking and
Main patch to show all commenced standing
at 11 one rock of standing at 5 in the
morning commenced standing down

Middle and later thick fog

Sunday 9th Fine weather Light breeze
from N at 4 PM finished standing 6.10.
took on board the howland from
Ship Power of N. Lundaan the bearing of
light and wanting to leave at 16 PM
standing at

light breeze from N. Saw and heard for
whales 3 but to no purpose
