 No success

Middle and later foggy much
 at 7 in the morning finish hauling
 70 Casks then commence steaming down

Later thick fog steaming down

Thursday 13. Thick fog steaming down all
 at 8 one finish steaming down 75 Casks
 then set 3 watches thick fog hasting N.E. W.

Middle fine weather standing to N.W.
 watch in play & in hauling bone
 at 9 P.M. Saw a large piece of ice
 up of for it at Mennison came up
 with it Saw no whales

Lat 64 40 Long 179 17. 1800

June 10 1850 Lat 63 30 Long 177 10 Land in site

Friday 14. Middle I standing to S.E. &
 one watch hauling bone at 7 P.M. past
 ash cutting quite foggy

Middle Middle I.M. 15 ship in site
 all steering different courses One by ship
 later fat saw the land

Lat 64 30 Long 177 20

Saturday 15. Fine weather light winds
 from S on the Stock 10 ship in site
 at 10 one saw and Land for whale
 No success Land in site

Middle Middle the same
 at 9 P.M. Saw and Land for whale
 but to no success

Lat 46 20 Long 174 34

Sunday 16. Light breeze from S.W.
 on the Stock. Saw Cape Wales
 8 ship in site steering different
 courses I am hauled N.

Middle Middle from S.E. and the Stock
 later strong breeze from S thick and rainy
 No obs

Monday 17. Strong winds from S.
 thick rainey at 7 P.M. one ship to S.E.
 took in fore and main by the 2 thick
 rainy and cold

Middle thick muggy and strong
 winds

later more moderate made saw
 sail thick fog a heavy swell from
 N.
