11 gave them up capturing at 1 in the morning

strakes one at 4 in the morning
took him to the ship at 10 commenced
capturing cutting 10 cubs 10 cubs 6
thick weather

Saturday 13 Thick weather cutting
a Hobbler whale at 6 PM finished
cutting then bore ship to 1 thick & raining
commenced capturing 300 blbs blubber
in the chubropan

Middle and later thick with rain
light rain and calm capturing

Sunday 14 Light breeze and calm
capturing Middle and later Middle
the same finished stowing down
100 blbs upon hole
Middle and later capturing

Monday 15 Fine weather Light
breeze from S W Landed 11 PM all
hands employed in capturing and
stowing water from fore hold
Middle and later Middle the
same 17 ships in site

Tuesday 16 Light breeze from
S W Landed 11 PM all hands employed
in capturing and stowing water
at 7 PM out of port to the coast
hauled to E S E Main yard a track

Middle and later Light breeze and
thick fog all hands employed in
stowing down oil and whaling
thick 2 whales down from
them both at 9 PM out of port
3 watches

Wednesday 17 Thick fog
Light breeze from S Stowing
down oil at 9 PM out of port
down 146 blbs thick fog

Thick fog all hands employed
in stowing down oil
