

Continued Cruising for Bokales

Thursday 25. More moderate thick fog lying at anchor at 2 PM. More moderate commence boiling Middle Moderate but thick fog

Later thick and rainy lying at anchor boiling 2 ships in sight Saw a few bokales

Friday 26. Light breeze from S. Thick and rainy lying at anchor boiling 2 ships in company these days are with thick and heavy and very luscious. I feel that it is not all what out of this world we saw other

Middle thick fog lying to anchor

Later thick and rainy cold down the works

Saturday 27. Strong breeze from N and thick rainy weather lying at anchor at 4 PM. Cold down started the works as a gain at 8 one the weather looking likely to be bad ship pitching quite hard. 1 of the 2 ships in company got underway

Middle fresh gales from S thick fog lying at anchor ship pitching hard

Later put under the same at 9 in the morning took my anchor saw the land steering N by E Lat 56.25 broke the windless

July 25<sup>th</sup> 1850 <sup>July 25<sup>th</sup> Capt. probably Bokale West</sup> Lat 65.00 Long 170.00

Sunday 28. Fine breeze from S W steering N by E quite clear at 4 PM thick fog drift to Main yard back heading "G" thick fog 22 farther west

Middle and later thick fog Main yard to the West don't know for sure

Monday 29. Thick fog more drift to W. Boat full at 5 PM. Sailed up. Saw the Land could not see Cape then steering N at 6 PM. Sailed for bokales no success at 9 came home 15 ships to N then steering N by W at 11 One Carpet anchor

Middle and later for thick fog boiling ship all round me

Tuesday 30. Thick fog wind all round compass lying to anchor. Captain Madde cold down

Later put standing down fore part. Thick and rainy winds

Wednesday 31. Thick weather lying at anchor standing down. All 10 ships in company saw cut in without boiling and standing down at 6 PM finished standing down 200 then set 3 watches in by 10 to quit a what to Morrow

Middle strong winds from N W got under way steering to the S

Later put the same in place in setting of the works
