fast at 1 Mennedon bay the wind
blowing harder than ever I hurried
to blow in my life was fast to take
in all sail I kept the ship before the wind
with 2 Mennedon the wheel I run under
my foresail all through the night
Mennedon passed by at 11 PM with
St Lawrence Island with heavy
gales from N. course S.
Then last night my oil and such and
let this go to the south as fast as
possible I now have 150 bls of
blubber in the blubber room and
100 bls of oil and such I wish it
was bottled out and stowed down
below
