Light strong gales from W
thick and rainy course S W by S & S

late must the same Lat 55 15 Long 174 20

Monday 16th Fine winds from W
and clear course S W by S.

Middle and late strong gales are
heavy weather No also to day

Saturday 17th Strong gales from
W course S W by S

Middle part the same late
more moderate make more sail

Lat 53 35 Long 172 00

Sunday 18th Light breeze from W
sharp up on the stack.

Middle and late thick &
No also

Monday 19th Light breeze from S
looked by ship to W thick weather
saw and passed with bark Corvinton

Middle and late light breeze from
S an oblique to S. Saw the Westernmost
Island of the Fox Islands
from this time up to the 19 light
winds from S

Lat 55 10 N Long 174 15 E

Saturday 20th Fine winds from
W with a heavy swell from W
course S E set down four top
gailut jores

Middle and late moderate set four
top most shrouding sail

No also to day

Sunday 21th Light winds from E W E
thick and rainy sharp up

Middle strong breeze with heavy
rains

Late strong with rain
No also to day

Monday 22th Strong winds from
W W gusting quite clear but
a heavy swell from E course
S E by E ship running q. g. through

Middle part moderate to S E
thick and rainy on the stack

Late strong S E winds thick and
no also

Tuesday 23th Winds S E thick
and rainy sharp up on the stack.
No also the same

Late winds hauls to W course
S E a heavy swell from S E
