23. Fine and pleasant weather

Barometer 11 degrees E

Barometer up to 30.10
fine weather

Middle part fine and pleasant
weather at 9 A.M. saw and sailed
for Wright wharf but to no success
at 11 A.M. came back
Steering S.E.

Lat 42.30 Long 164.46

Increasing the light winds from
N.W. by E. Steady sail
at 10 A.M. left of plenty of fish
in the hope to do
Wright wharf soon and
quit one on more

at 7 A.M. saw and sailed for whales
No success at 10 A.M. saw and
sailed for whales struck killed at 12 took
them to the ship so crew employed
in cutting getting ready to eat

No obs
Wednesday 25 fine weather light
breeze from N at 1 P.M. commenced
cutting at 5 finished cutting then made
all sail steering S.E. commenced
baying

Middle & Late the same
employed in baying course E by S
